I've only gone to rest a little while.*

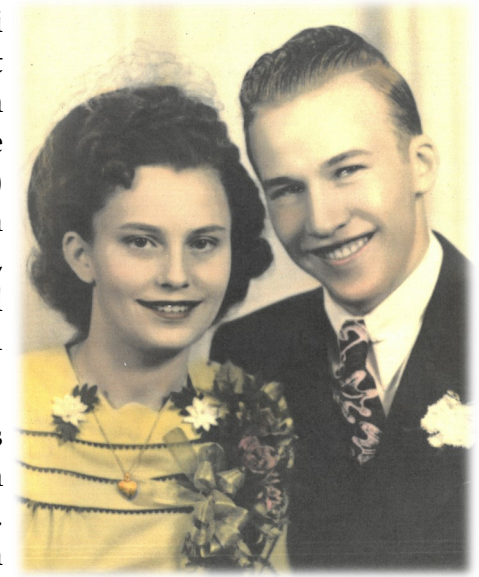
*Although my leaving causes pain and grief,
