He made not one mistake

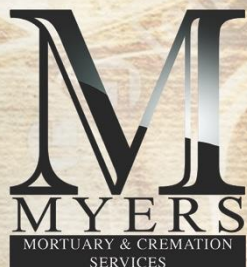
