THE OBITUARY

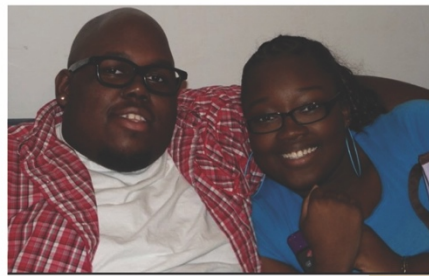
