Celebrating The Life of Larry Charles Williams

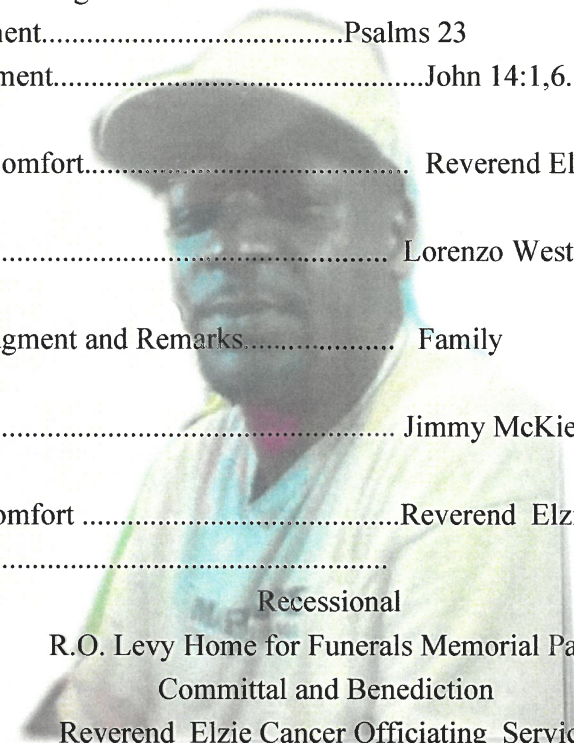


Larry Williams (Skitter), was born December 9, 1960 in Batesburg
