Edmund Borowicz, 90, of Forest Lake, MN, passed away on Saturday morning, January 29, 2022, one day shy of his 91st birthday, at Birchwood Health Care Center in Forest Lake.

Edmund Conrad Borowicz was born on January 30, 1931 to Steve and Mary Ann (Chwialkowski) Borowicz on the farm his grandfather, Martin Borowicz, homesteaded in 1905. Edmund lived on this farm most of his life. He attended Country School at Florian MN. Edmund was baptized and confirmed in the Assumption Catholic Church of Florian where he was a lifetime member.
