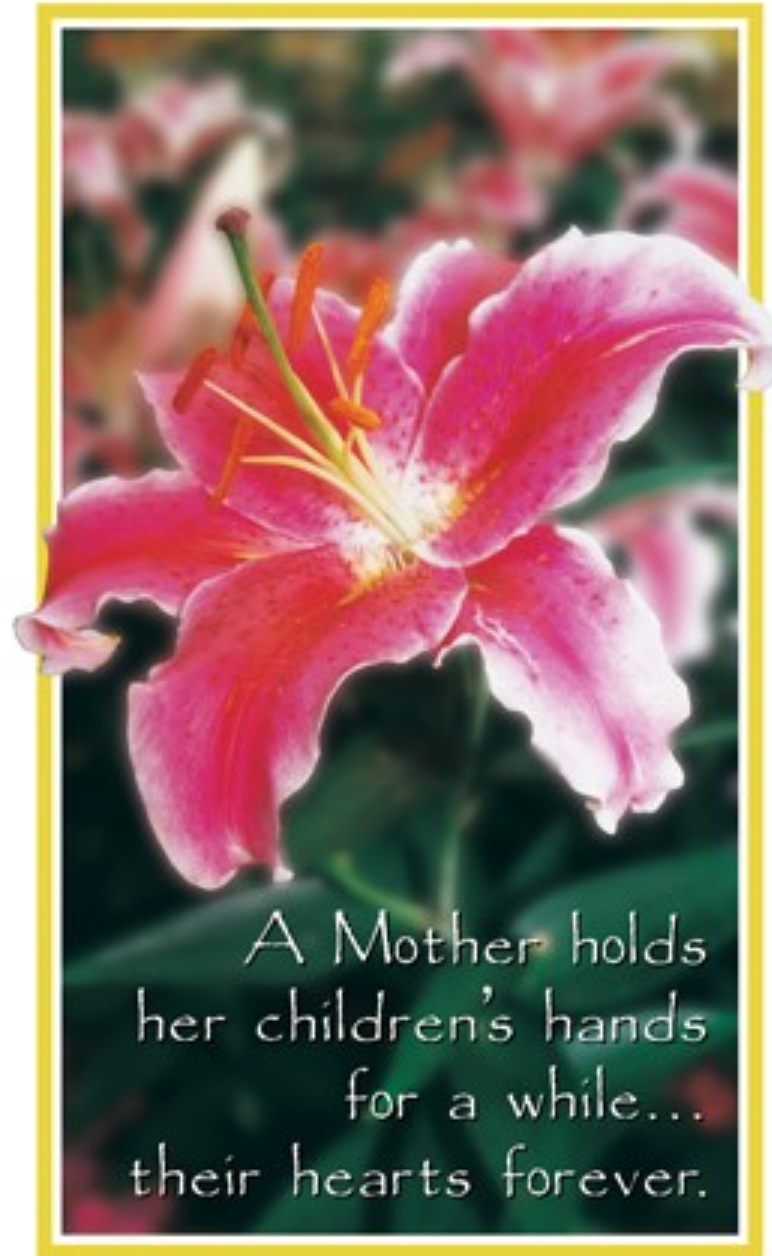
When tomorrow starts without me
