THE OBITUARY OF LLOYD



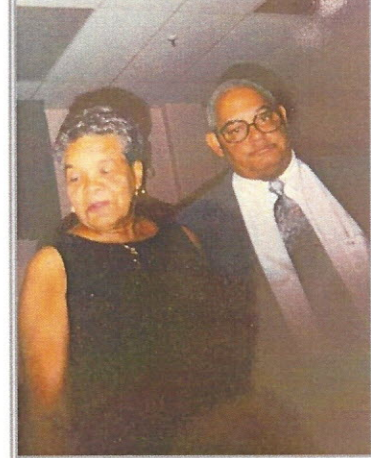
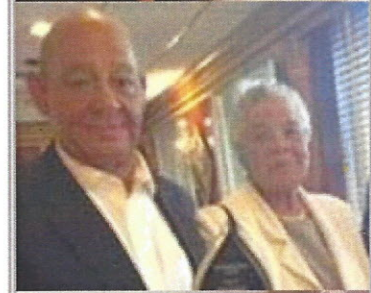
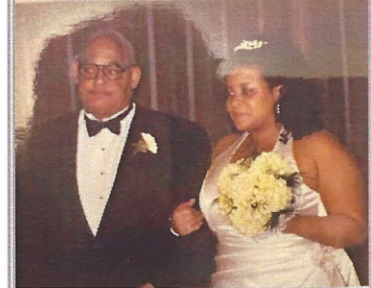
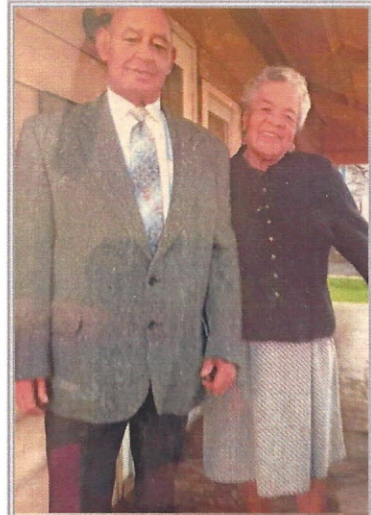
