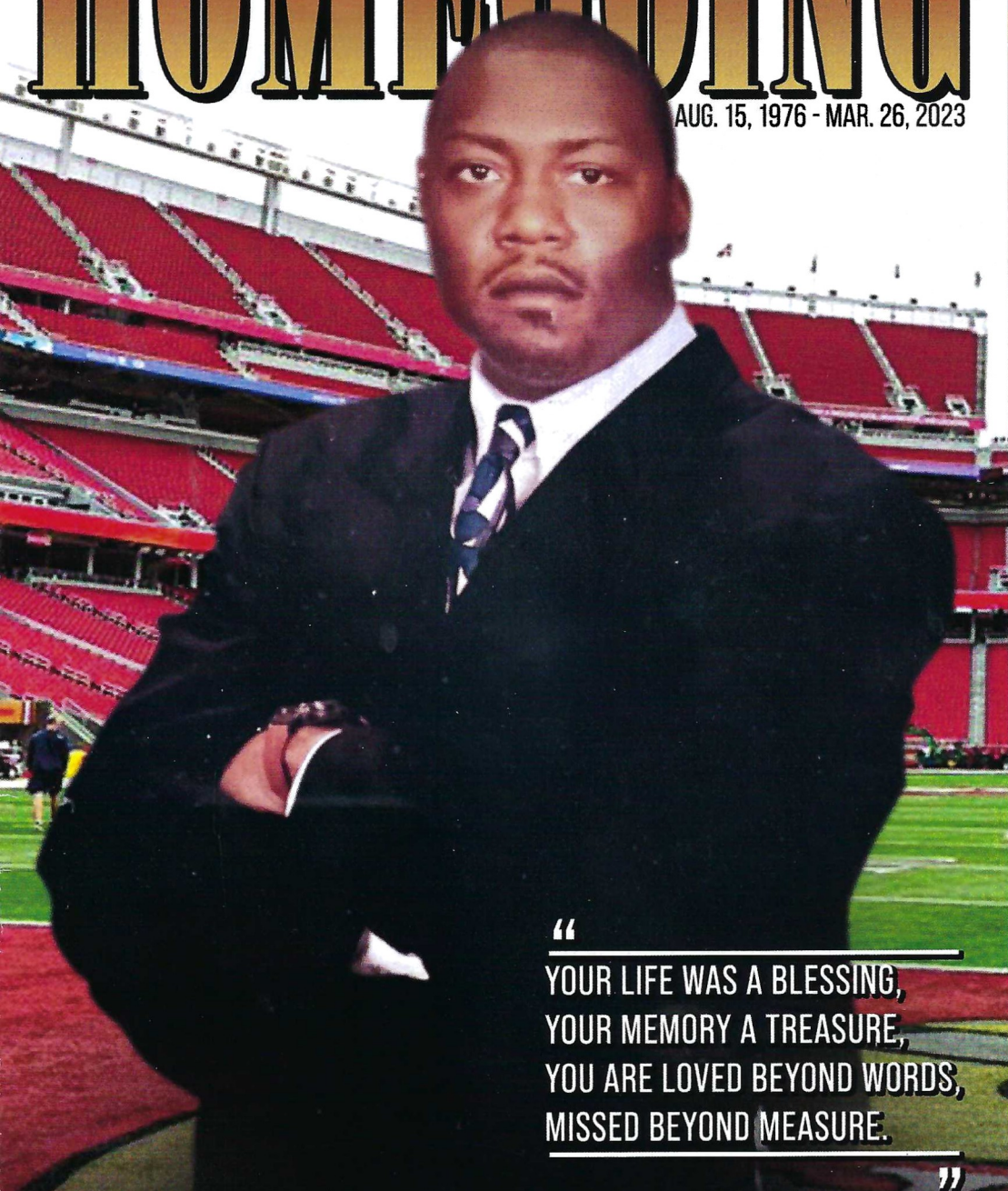

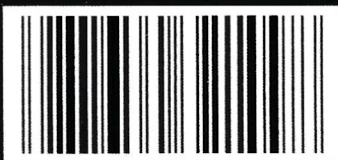

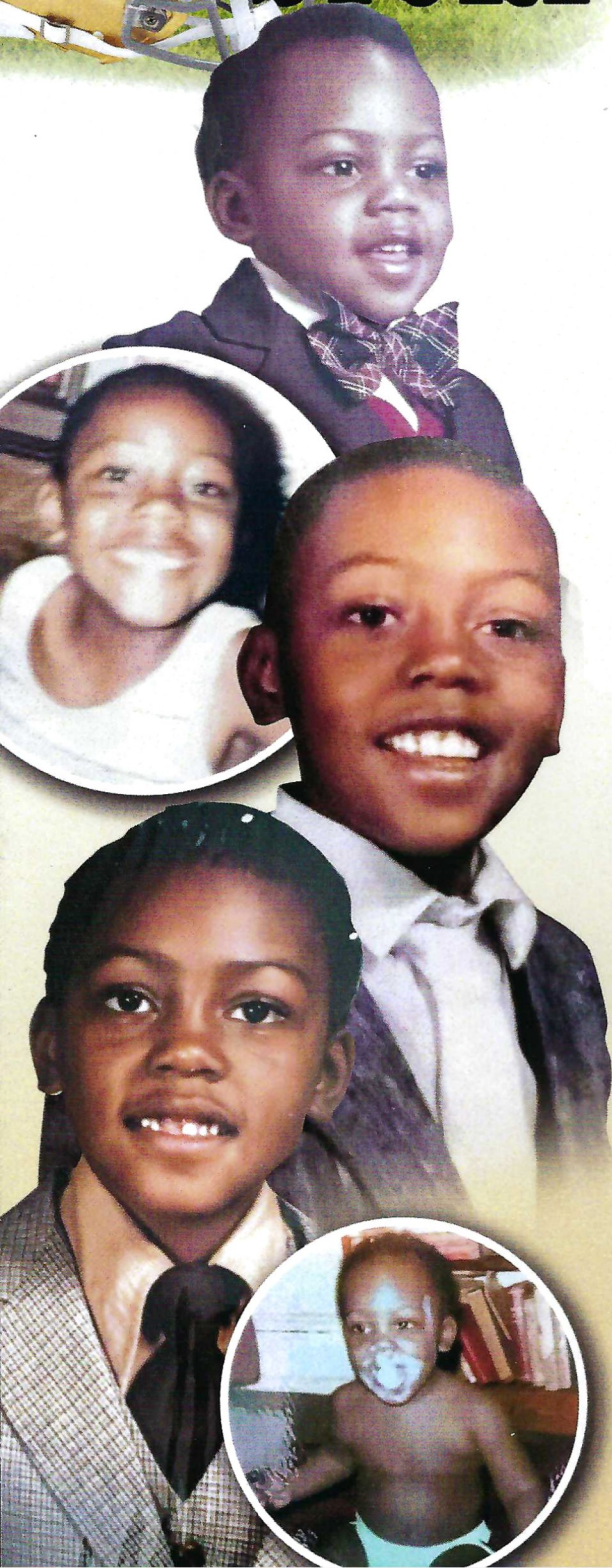

HIS STORY



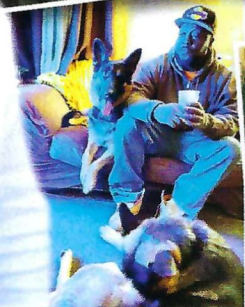
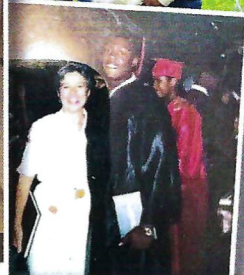
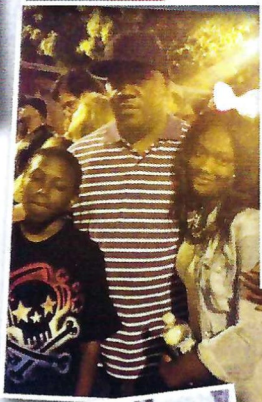

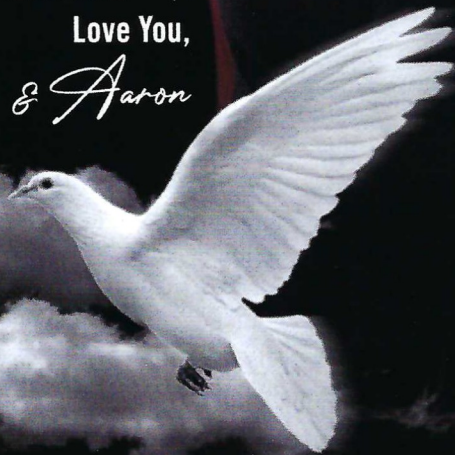


Remembering Our Father
