She graduated from Trenton Central High School in Trenton, New Jersey in 1971.


On May 31st, 2013, she retired from Trane/Ingersoll-Rand (Trenton Plant) after 41 years of dedicated service.



For nothing in life that is worthy, is ever too hard to achieve.


If you have the courage to try and you have the faith to believe.
