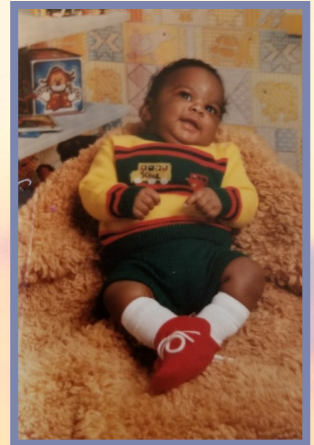
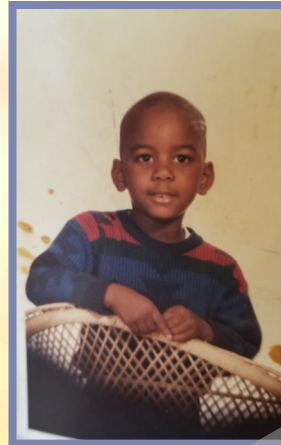
RECESSIONAL
