Leoner Osgood was born on September 23, 1939 to the late Sara and the late Leo Osgood in Charleston, South Carolina. She was the oldest of three children; the late Leo Osgood and the late Leila Jackson. Leoner accepted Jesus Christ as her personal Lord and Savior and baptized at historical Twelfth Baptist Church, on Shawmut Avenue during the Reverend Dr. William Hunter Hester era.

Leoner was educated in the Boston Public Schools. After graduation, Leoner married Edward L. Woodson, Jr. and in this union they had five sons, a daughter and was foster parent to many children in need. During this time she worked as a caregiver, lunch aide for the Boston Public Schools and worked on former State Representative Doris Bunte's multiple campaigns. Later in life she attended Roxbury Community College and went on to continue her education at Endicott College, where she earned a B.S. degree in nursing. She still found time to be invoked in her community through volunteering at the Robert Gould Shaw House, Operation Exodus, METCO, and the Freedom House.

On Saturday, December 19th, after an illness and hospitalization, Leoner was called from labor to reward. She leaves to cherish her memory her husband, Edward L.
