our hearts to prove to us he only takes the best.*

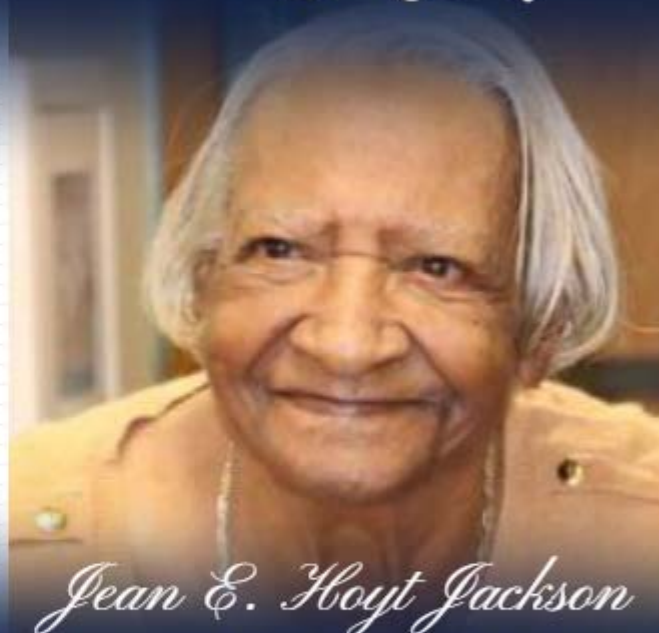
