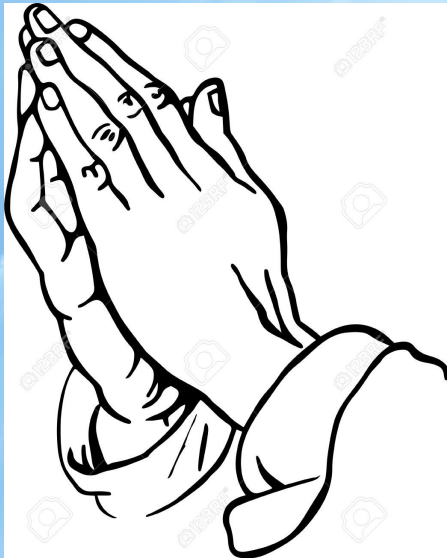
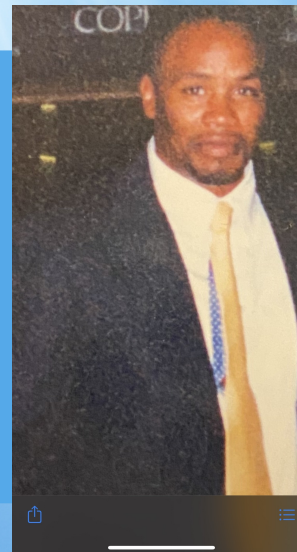

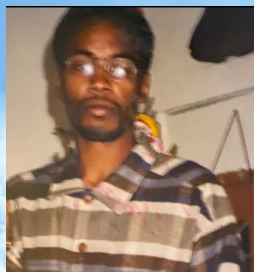
OBITUARY
