

## Broken Chain

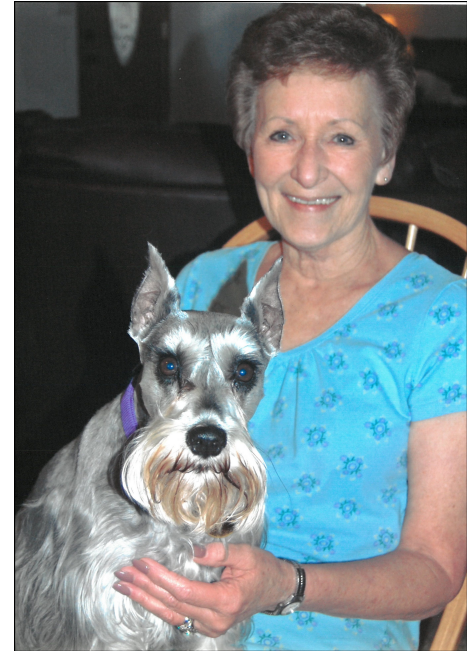
We little knew that morning that God was
