MARY DIANN CRAWFORD BATTS, known as "Diann" or "Lady Di", was born on September 22, 1954, in Marlin, Texas, to Mr. Archie Jack Crawford and Mrs. Mary Jane O'Neal Crawford.

SHE united with Macedonia Baptist Church in Bremond, Texas, at a very young age. While at Macedonia, she served in the choir, as youth director, and as the church secretary. She later moved her membership to Pleasant Grove Baptist Church in Waco, Texas, and remained a faithful member, serving in the choir, Mission I, and decorating committee until her untimely death.

DIANN attended Bremond High School in her hometown of Bremond, Texas, where she was one of the top elite students in her graduating class of 1973. After high school, Diann married Gregory Batts. After getting married, she attended TSTI (now known as TSTC)Dental Assistant Program, graduating cohort of 1976. To the union of Diann and Gregory, one daughter was born, Constance Batts.
