Jonn was a member of Chapel Hill United Methodist Church.

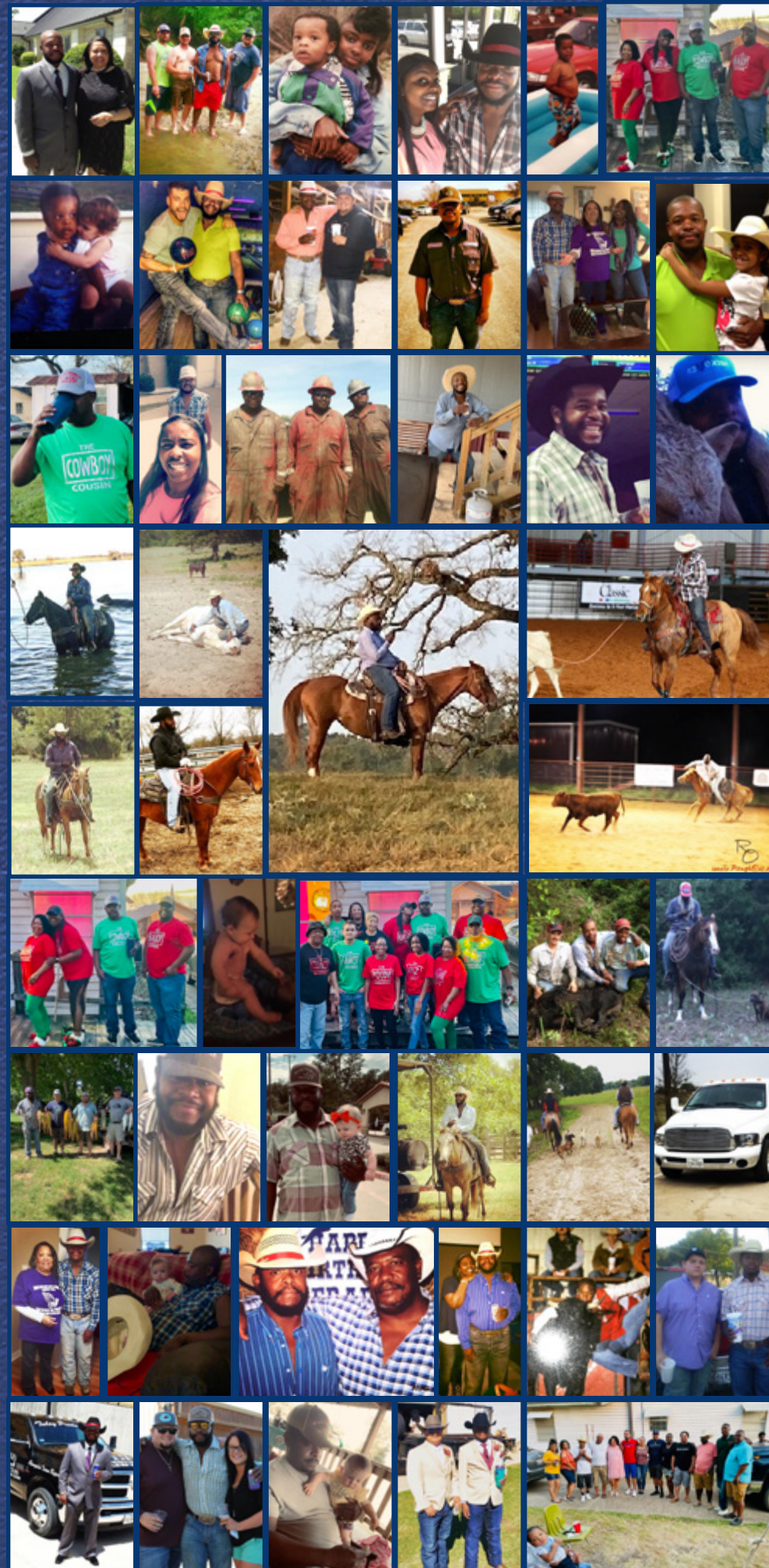
