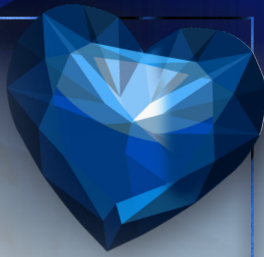


MY FIRST LOVE
