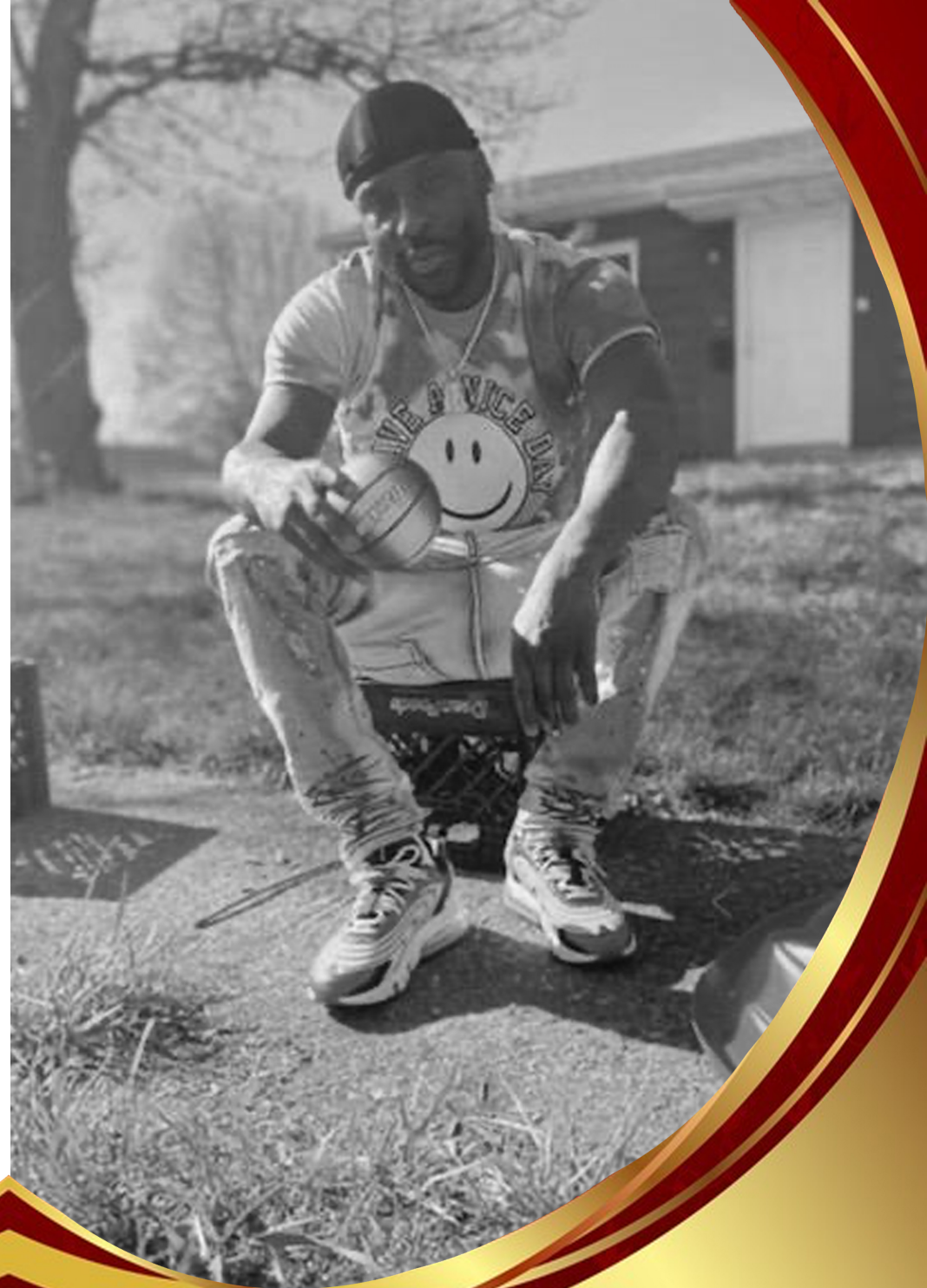

God wanted me now - He set me free.



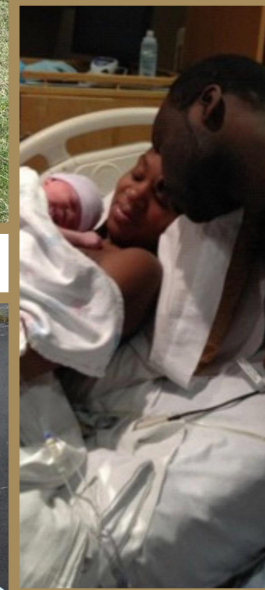
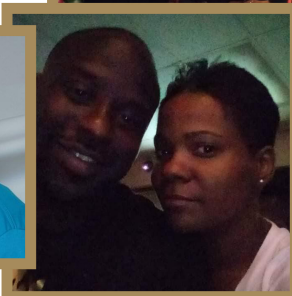
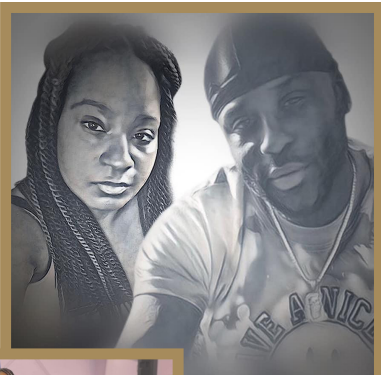
The Obituary
