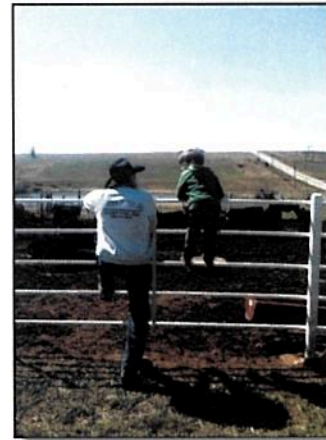
David Thieme, 63, of Sabetha, Kansas passed away Sunday, October 28, 2018.
