I wish you the sunshine of tomorrow.

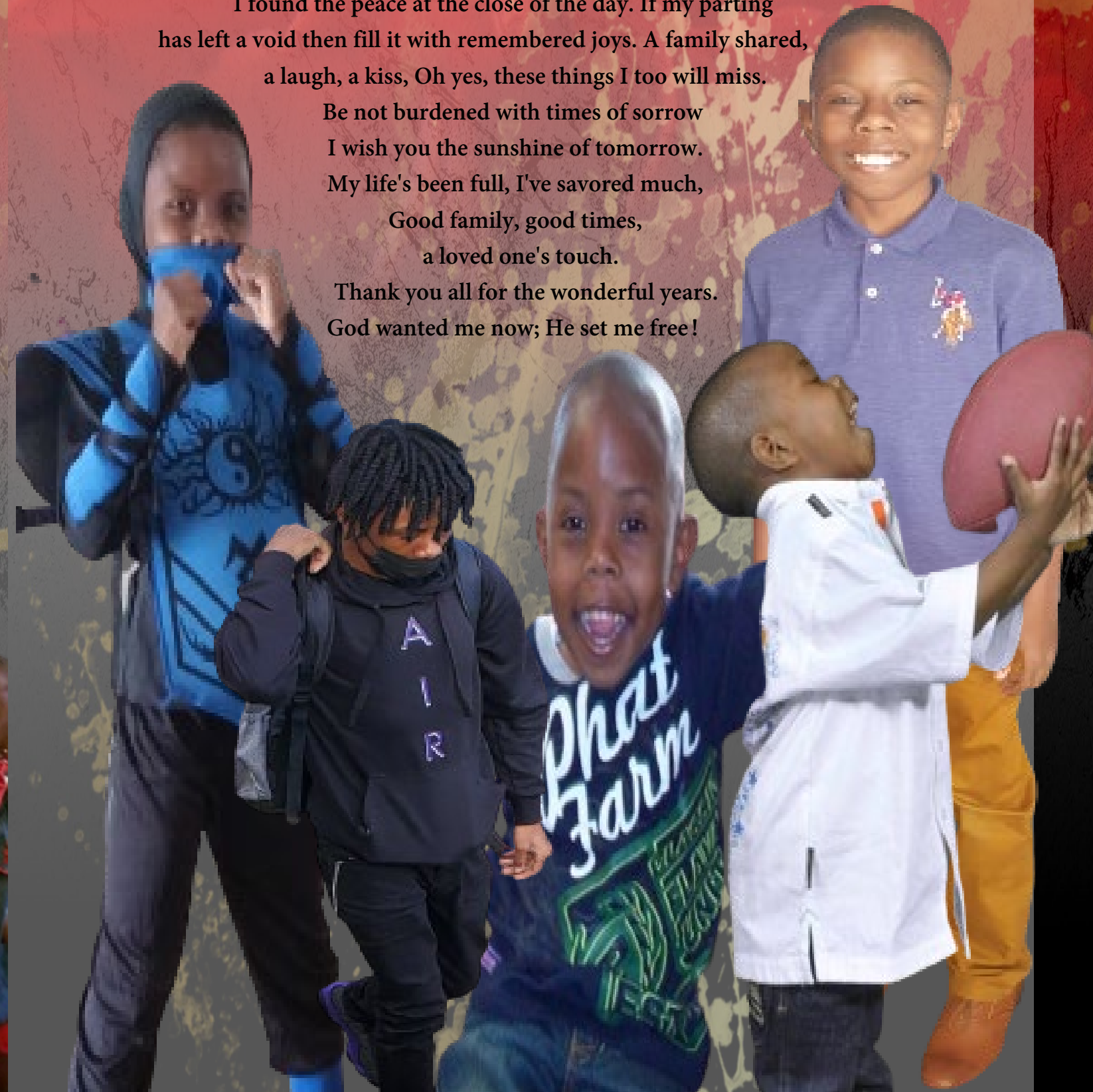
