'The Obituary'

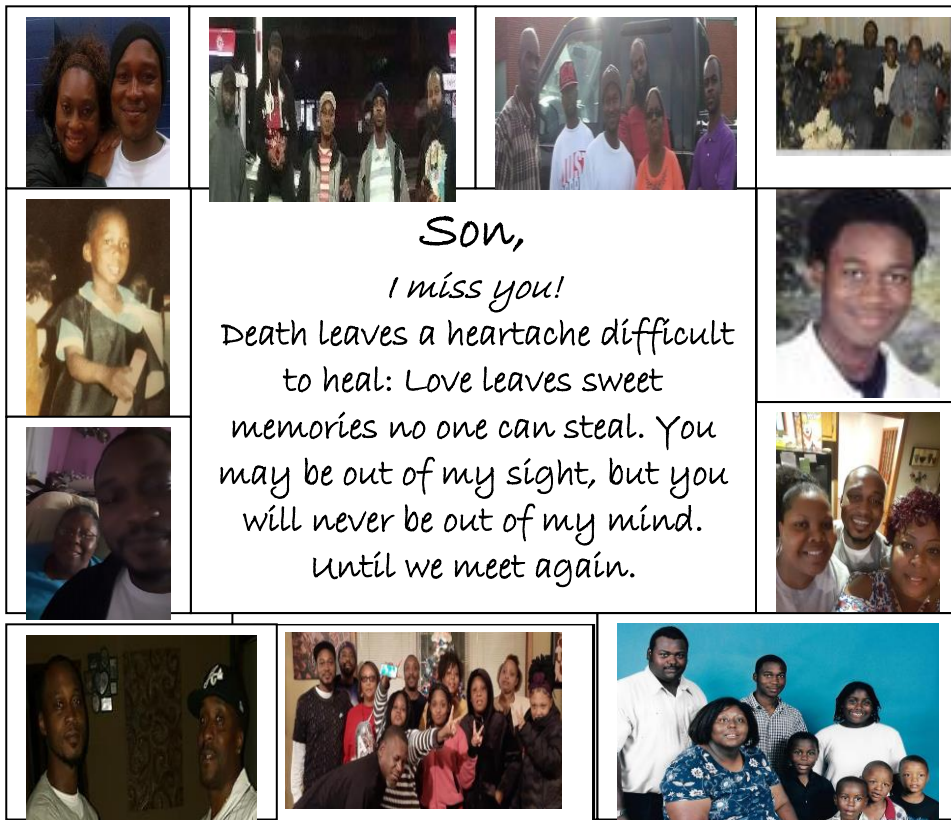

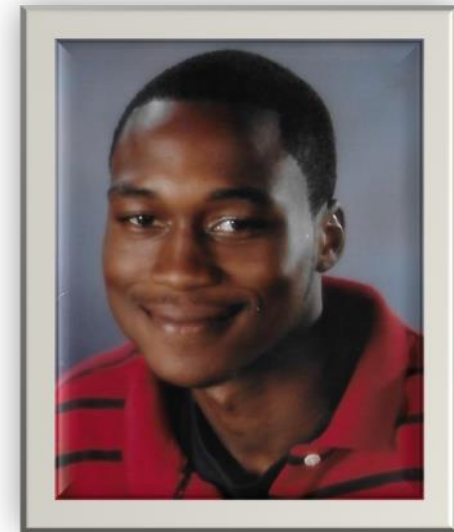
