Obituary

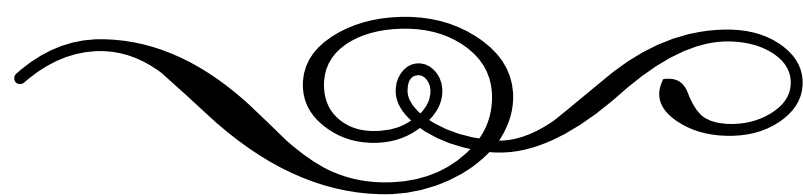

Don't Cry for Me

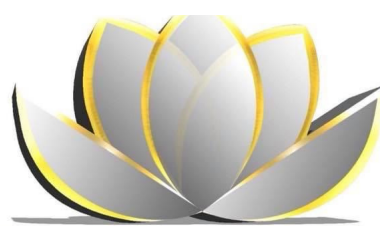
Don't cry for me when I'm gone
