Elsie's Recipe for Turkey Dressing!

- D. Add a de-cored apple, leave skin on, in chunks.
- E. Fry mix and mix well.. if not sticking together, add ½ c of hot water till it sticks!
- F. To stuff Turkey see side B.

SIDE B: for stuffing mix in turkey!! Take turkey and rinse the turkey out. Neck to bum, ect. Stuff the rear end take legs together and put it under pope's nose. Tie legs up and if he's a big fellow! Take a pc. Of bread to lock stuffing in if neck has big hole, stuff it too! Tuck neck skin around it.
