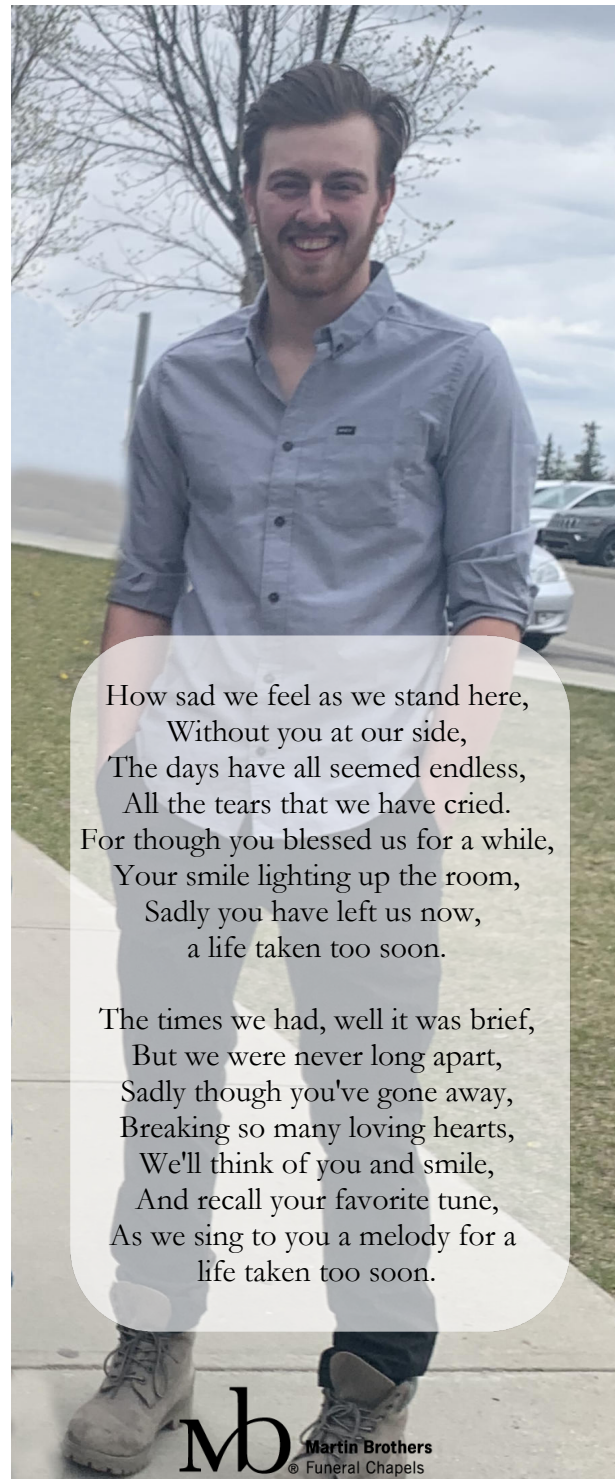




*Race the Rain, Ride the Wind,
