LIFE OF Terrance "Trey" Satchell

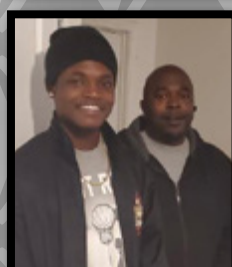
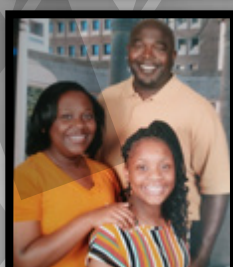
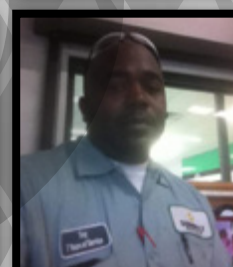
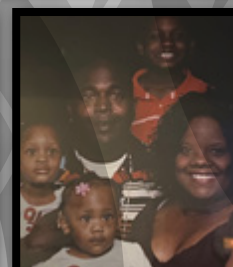
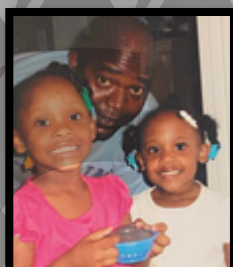
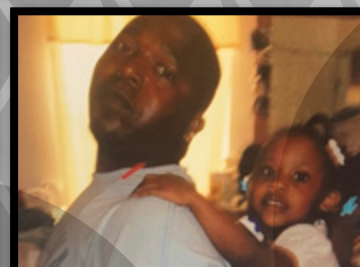
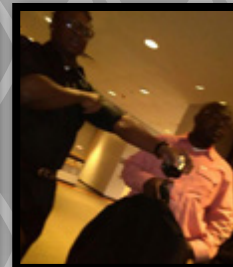
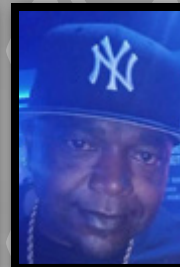
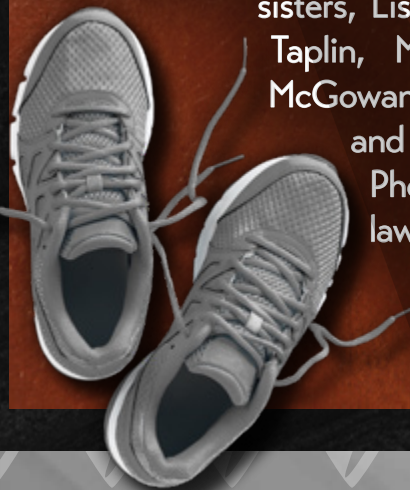
