Reflections of Life

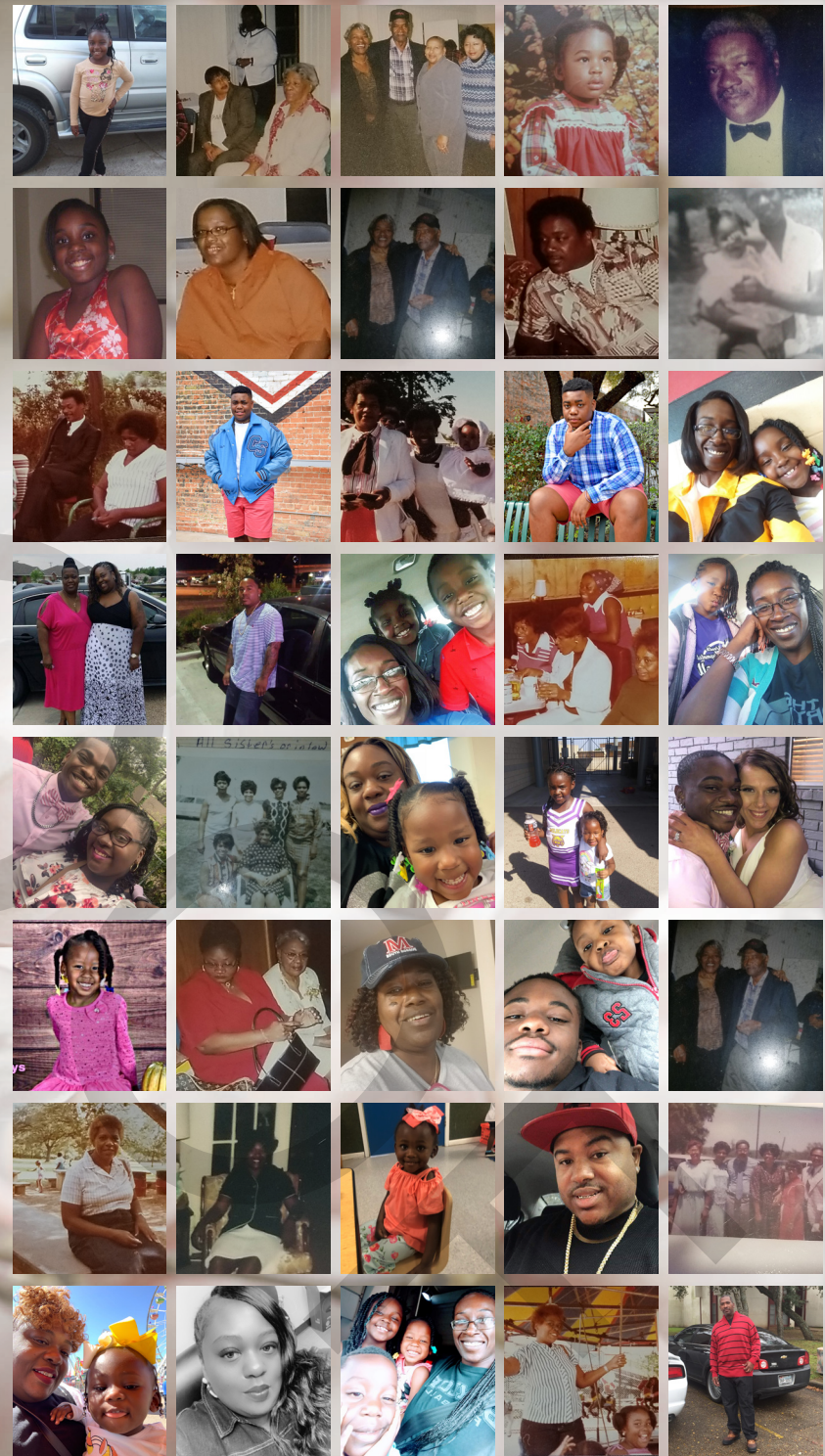

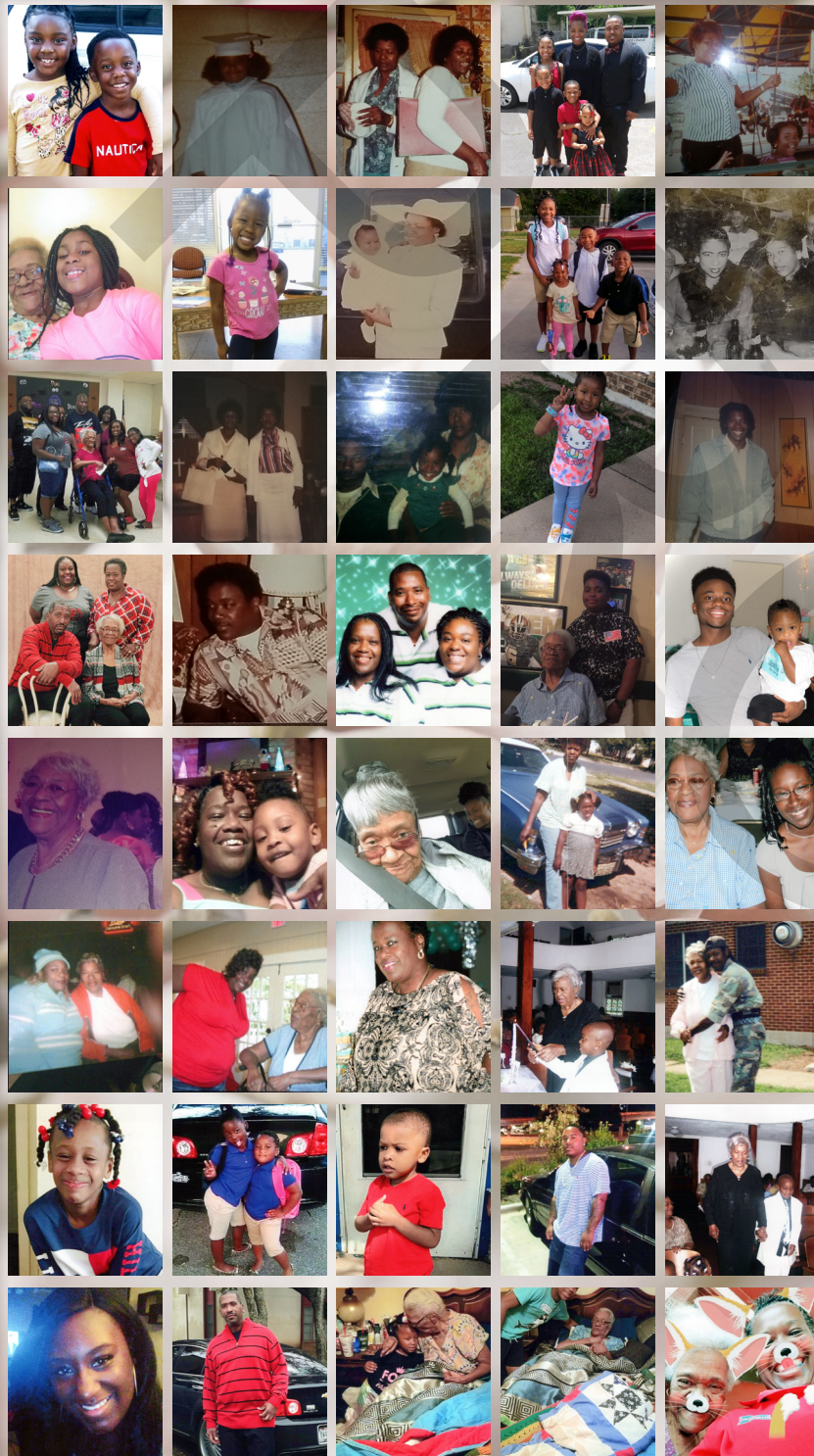
