

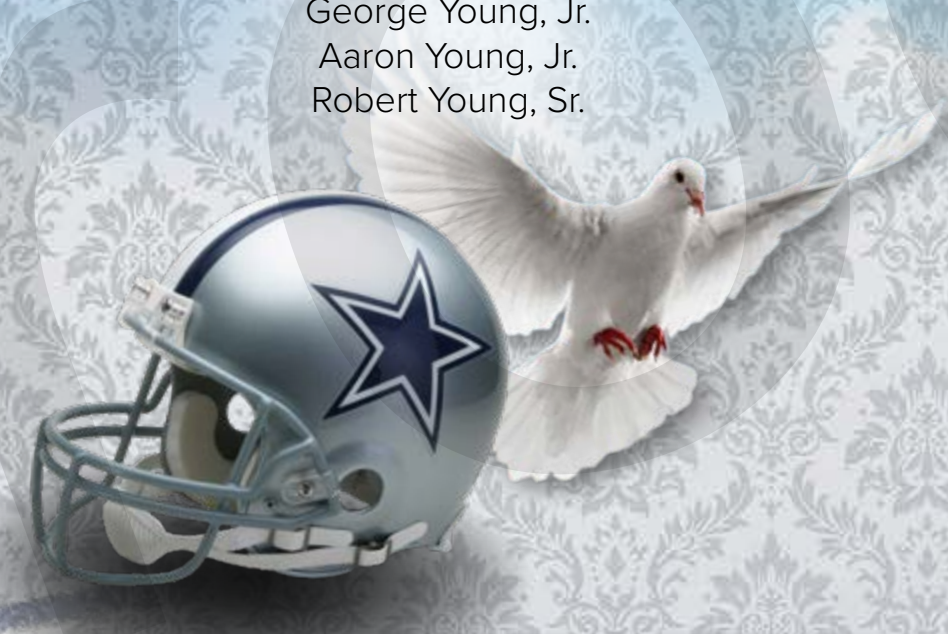

Obituary

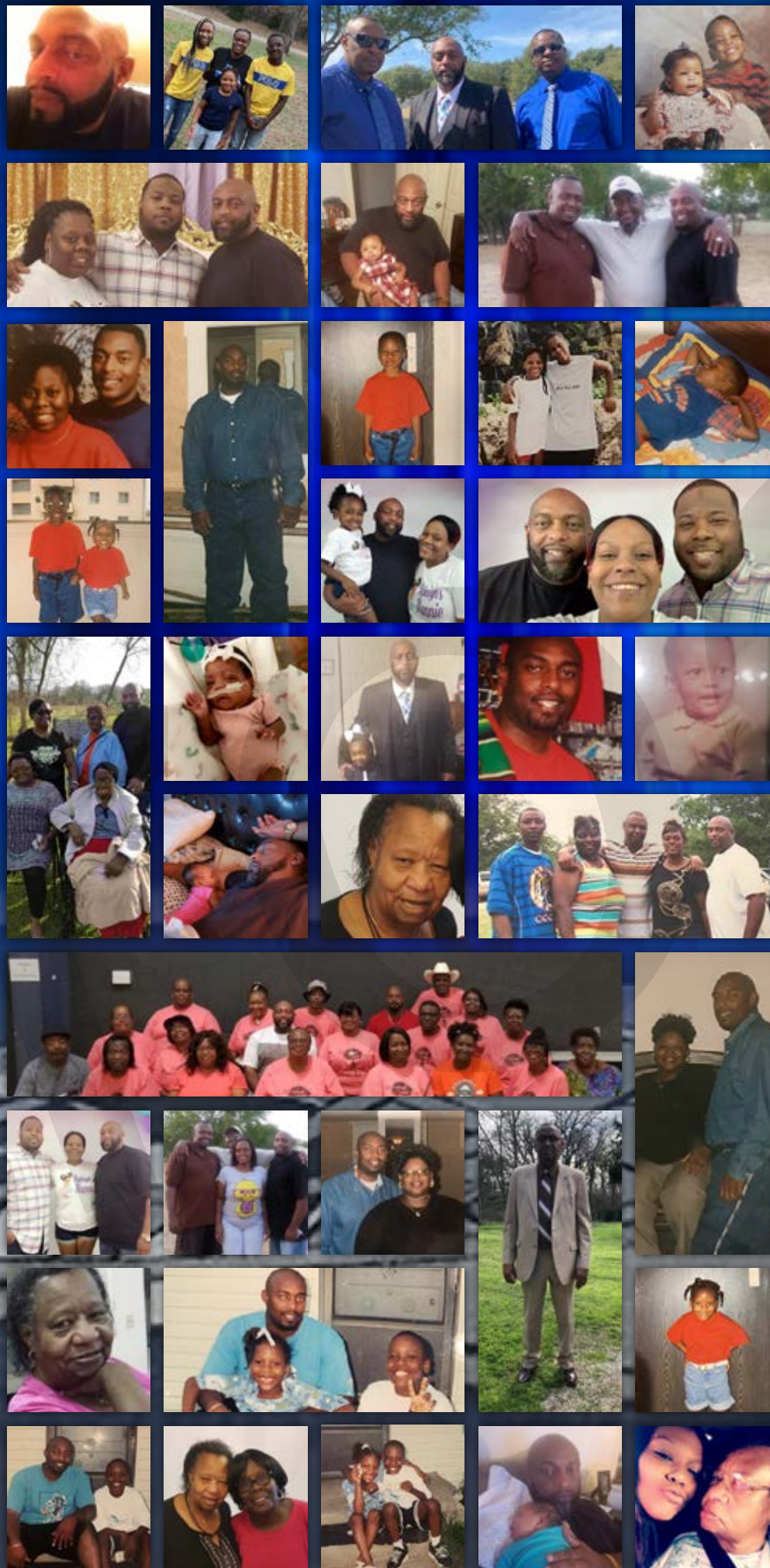
