LeROY attended schools in Waco, Texas. He was a proud University High Trojan and was super, super proud to be a resident of South Waco, aka “South Side.”

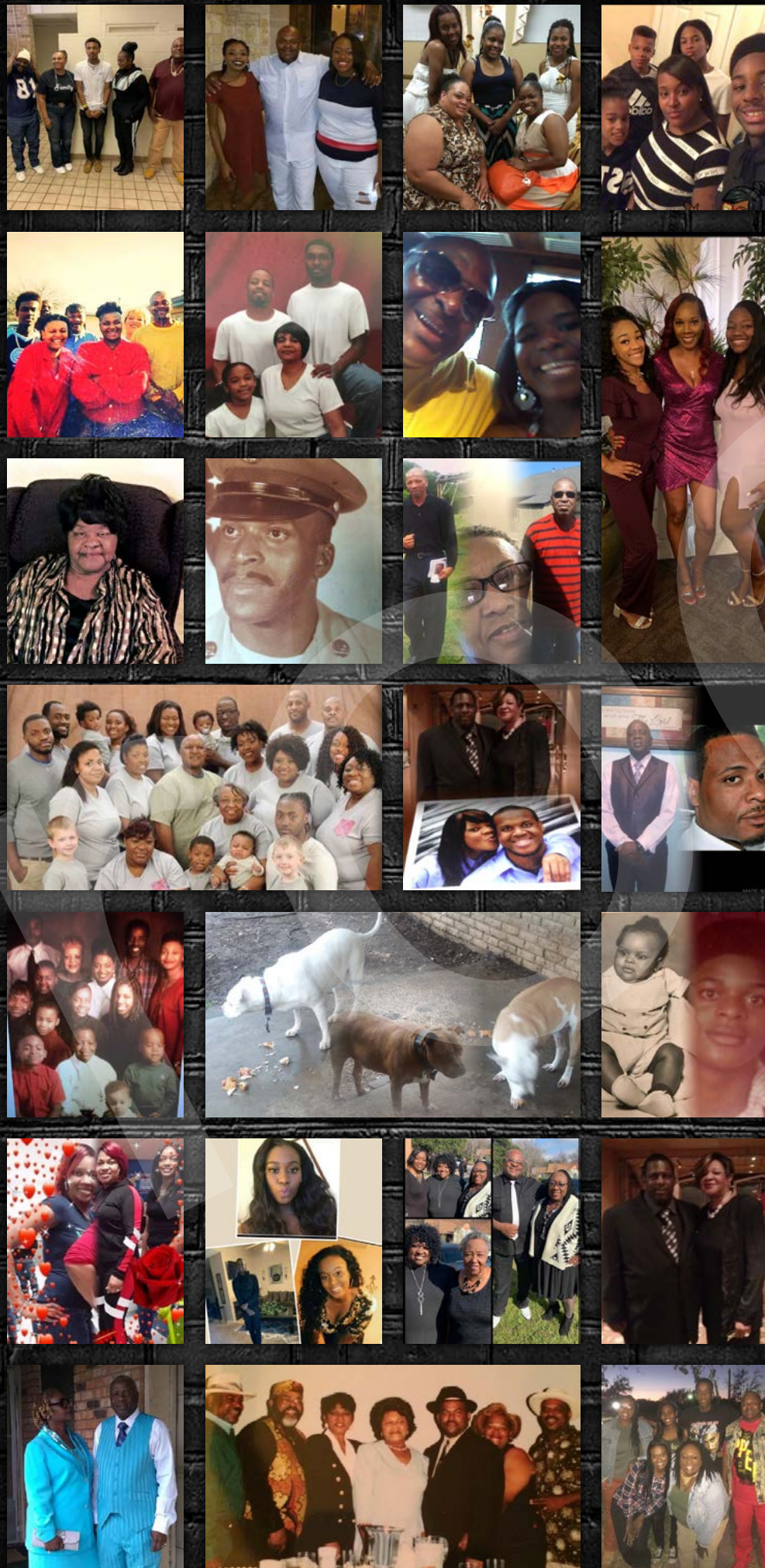
LeROY was employed with Connally ISD, Waco ISD and Baylor University.
