Reality shakes me and speaks so loud and clear

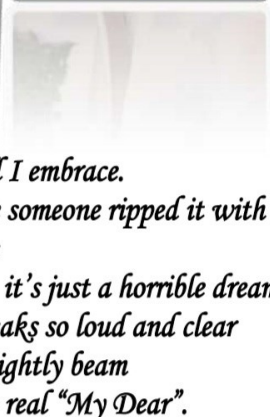

Saying that it's really real "My Dear".

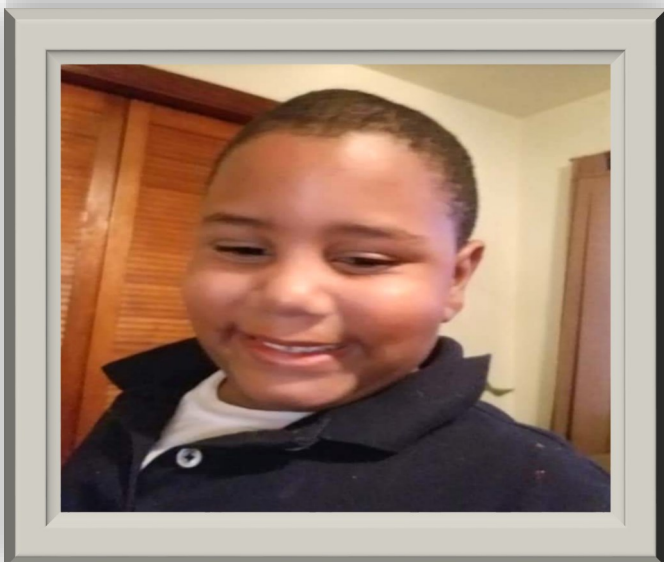
So I dry my eyes and say "In All Things Give Thanks".

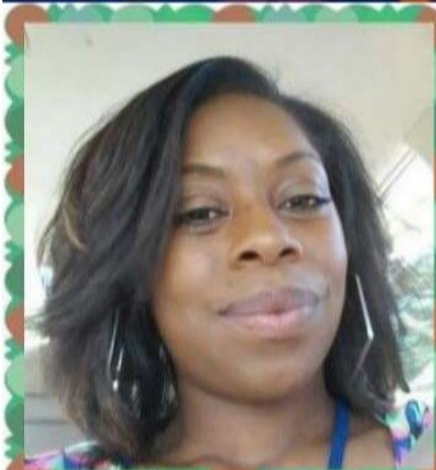
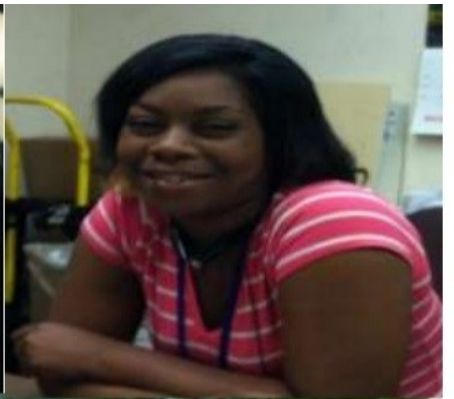


Dear Brittney
