Adetokunbo Oluwatomi Adigun Okunoye, MBA, a prince from Iba, Nigeria was born at Royal Victoria Hospital, Banjul, The Gambia on June 16, 1997. He was born to HRM Oba (Prof.) Adekunle Okunoye, Eburu of Iba, Iba Osun state, Nigeria and Gbemisola Okunoye. He came to Cincinnati, Ohio in 2004 with his father, mother, and younger sister.

He attended Hartwell Elementary School in Cincinnati, and then to Welch Elementary in Pleasant Run Farms before moving back to Nigeria to attend Trinity International College, Ofada, Ogun State. He returned to Cincinnati where he graduated from Northwest High School in 2013. He graduated with a Masters in Business Administration from Xavier University where he also earned his BSC.

He worked as a lab technician at Schlumberger and then as a manager at Amazon before settling in data analysis at Protiviti. He had begun a Masters in IT at the University of Cincinnati and gained the prestigious opportunity for fellowship with the Department of State for the 2022 Foreign Affairs Information Technology Program.
