You Meant So Much

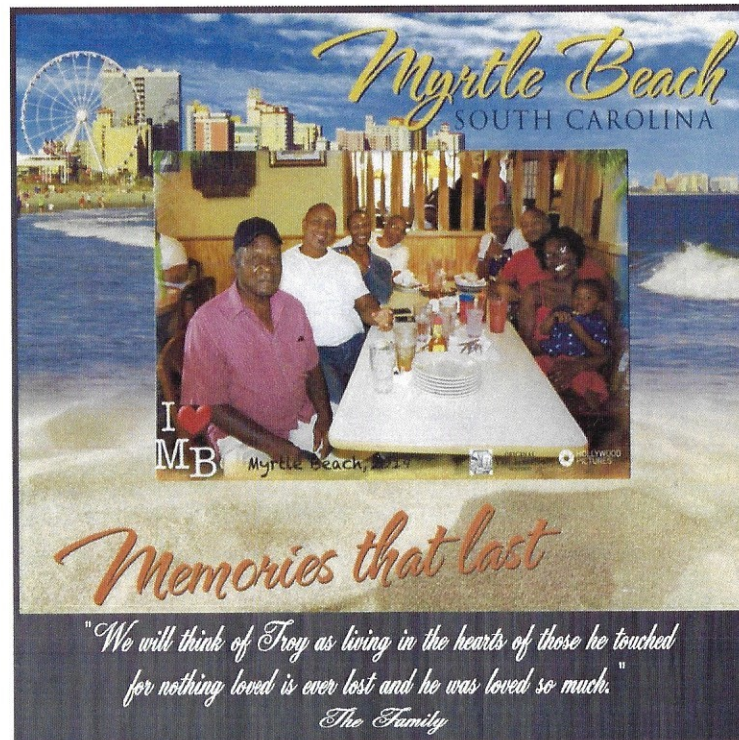
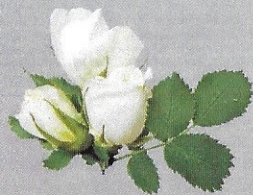
You meant so much to all of us

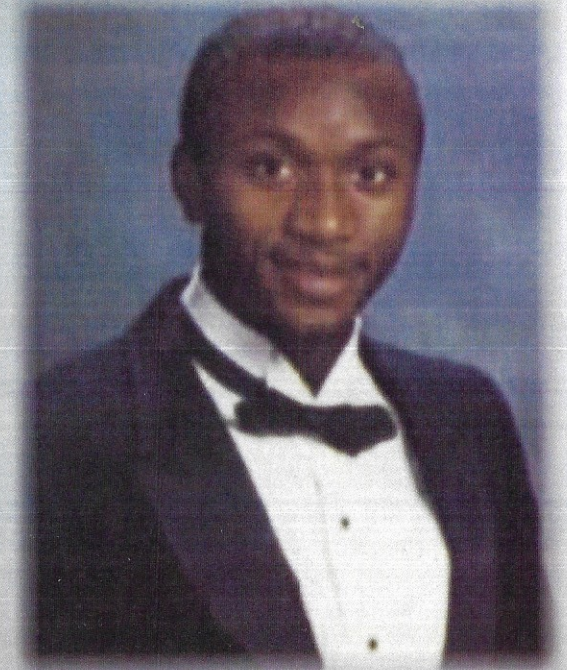
