Lee accepted Christ as his Savior. He joined Chalk Hill Baptist Church in Wagener, SC at a young age and served as the 2nd oldest continuous member. After moving to Columbia, he regularly attended 1st and 3rd Sunday services and Revival services. His support grew to him developing a Back To School Supply Drive because he did not want children to attend school without supplies while obtaining an education. His caring for others continued even after he graduated from A.L. Corbett High School. He had an outstanding record as school bus driver, earned industrial mechanical studies scholarships, served as a licensed barber and provided protective services within The United States Army during the Korean War. He shared his newly found musical talents of the guitar within the barracks for his comrades.
