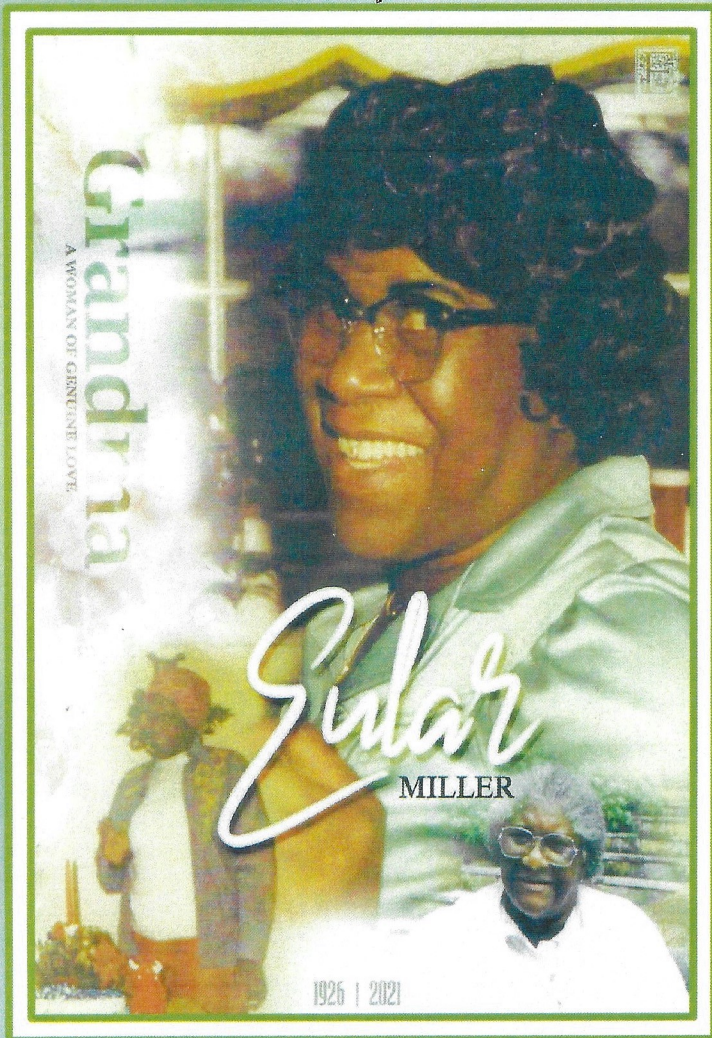

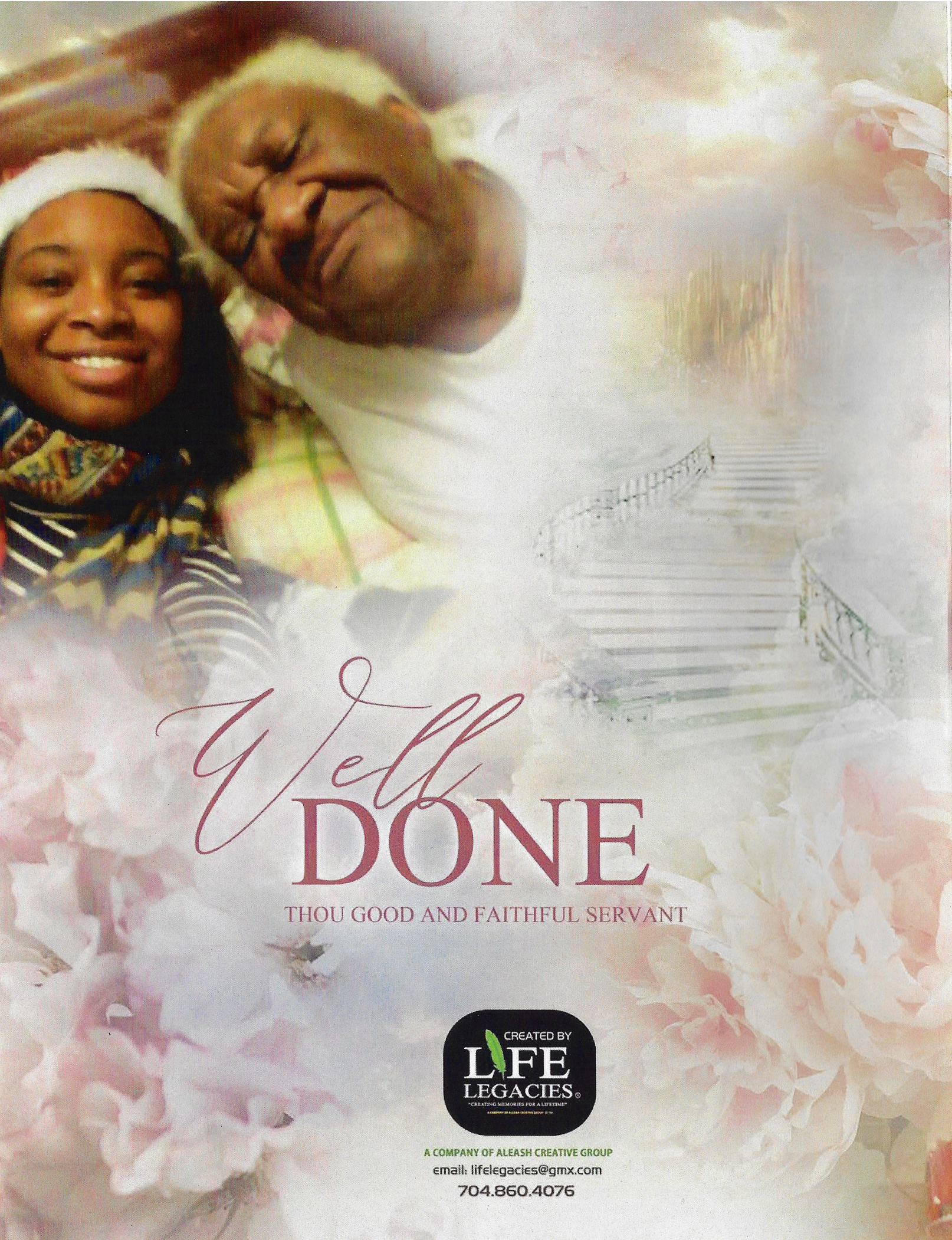
Obituary

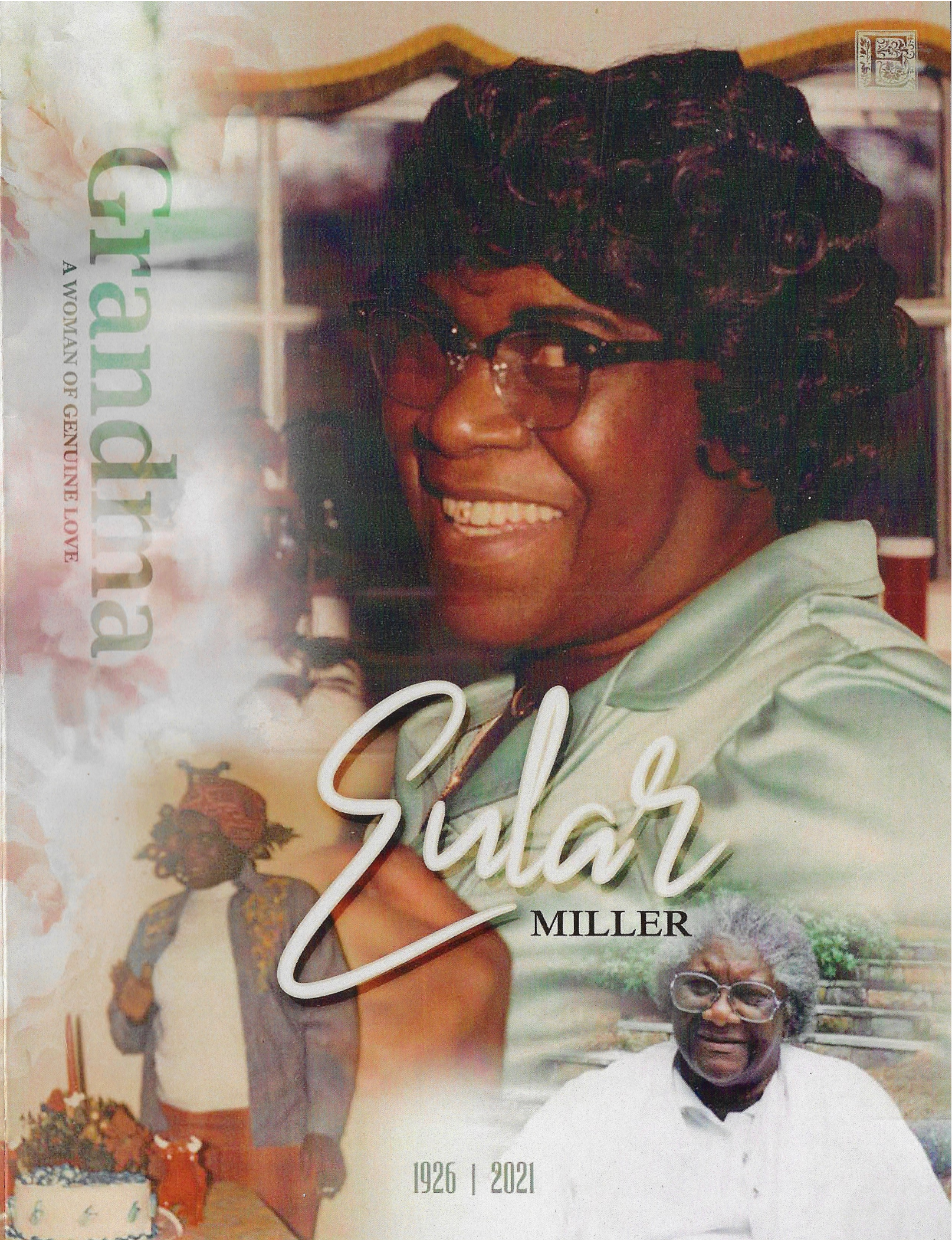

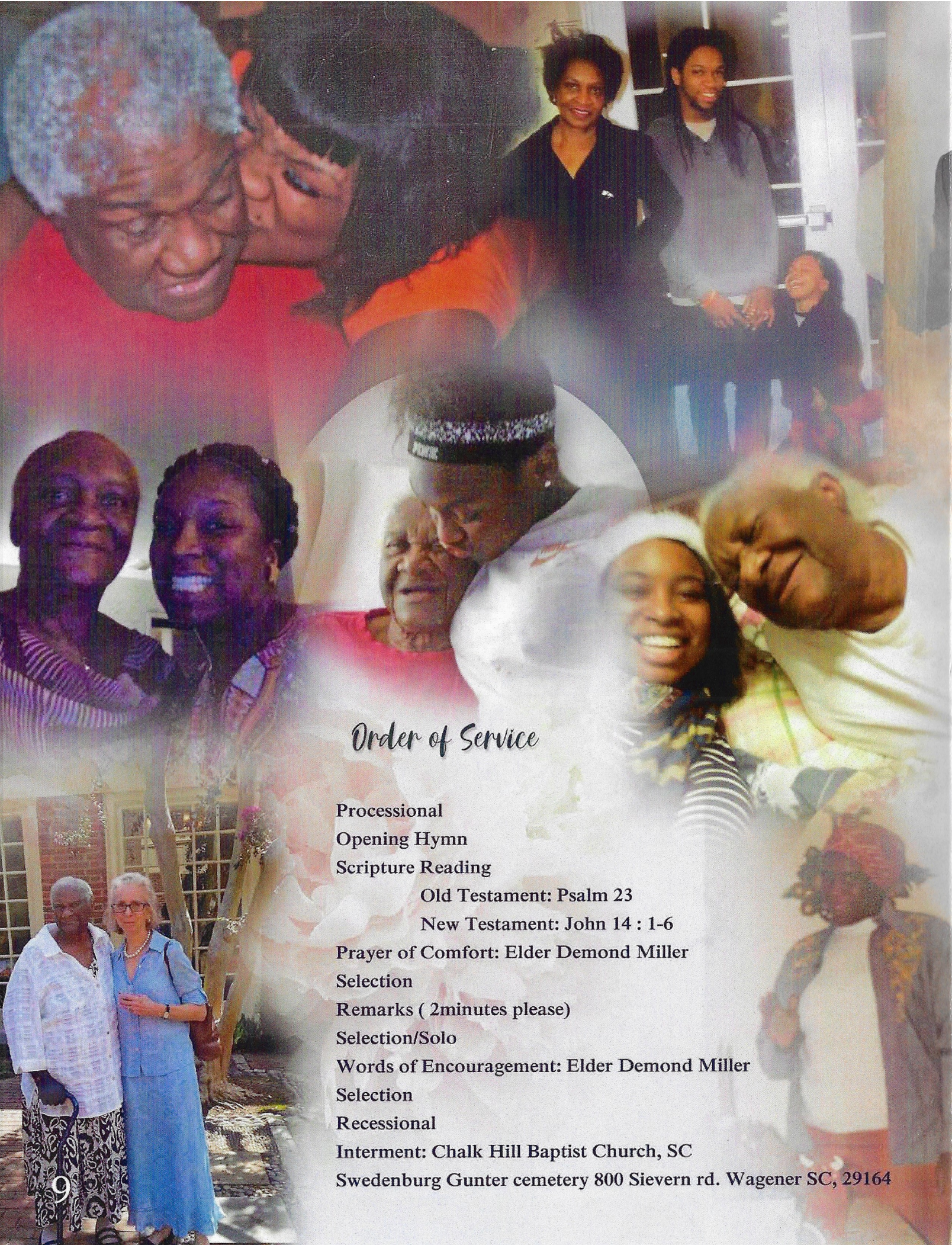
