

## HOMER JUNIOR LARUE

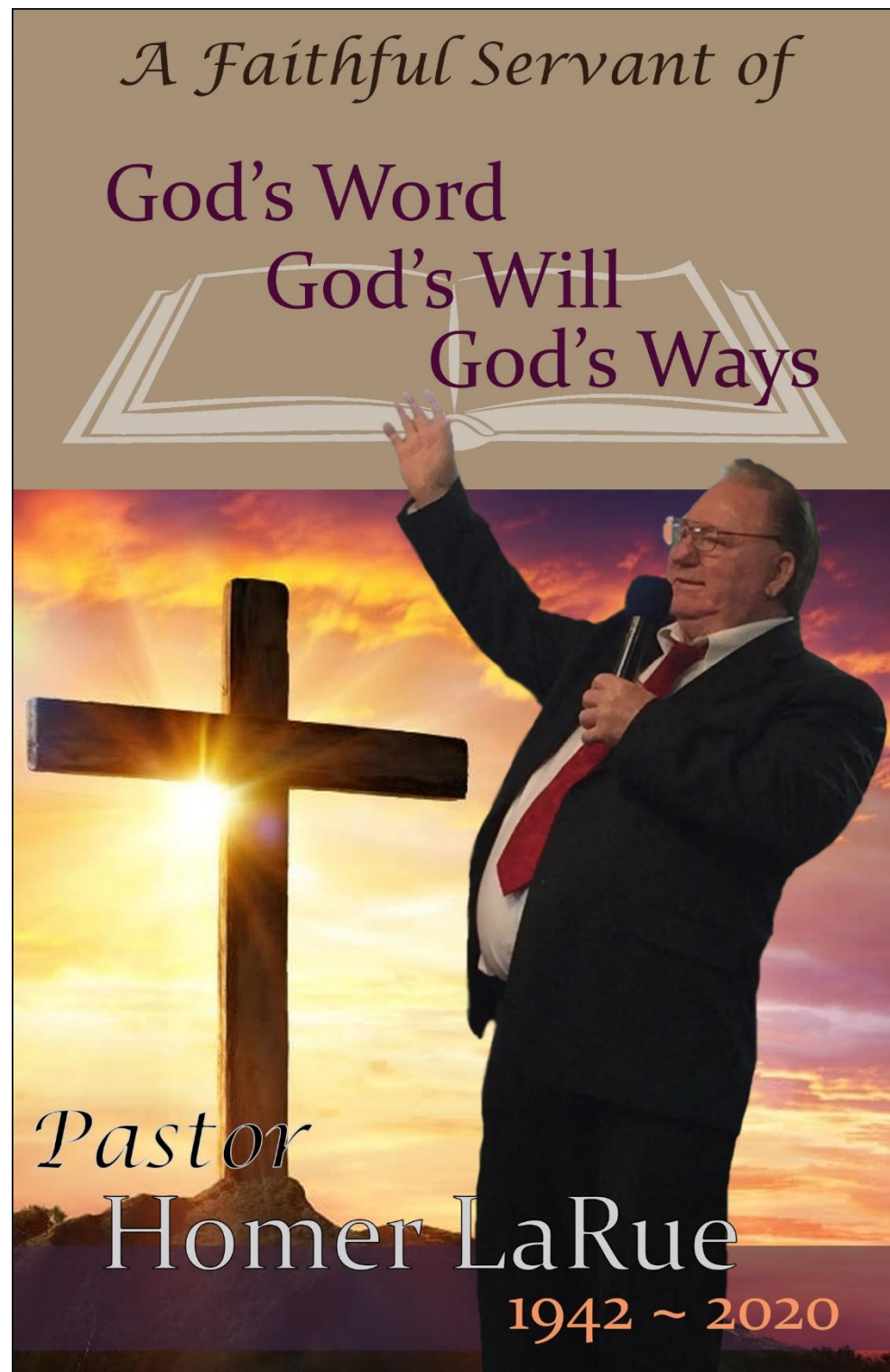
