

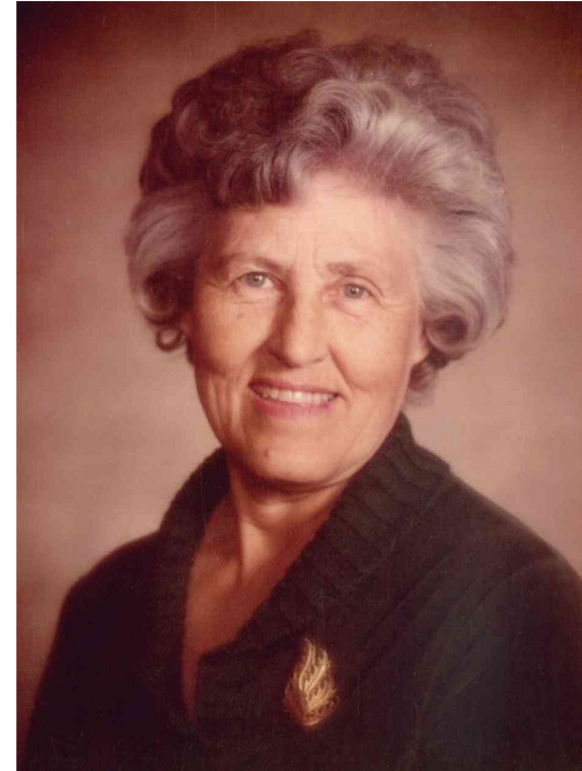
Amazing Grace
