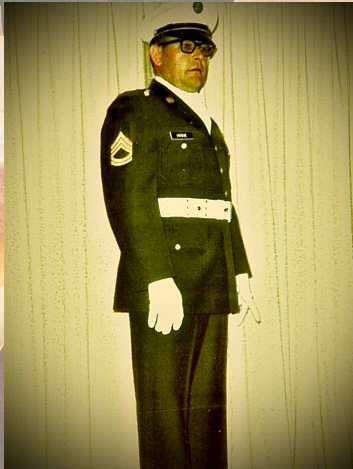


I Am Always With You


