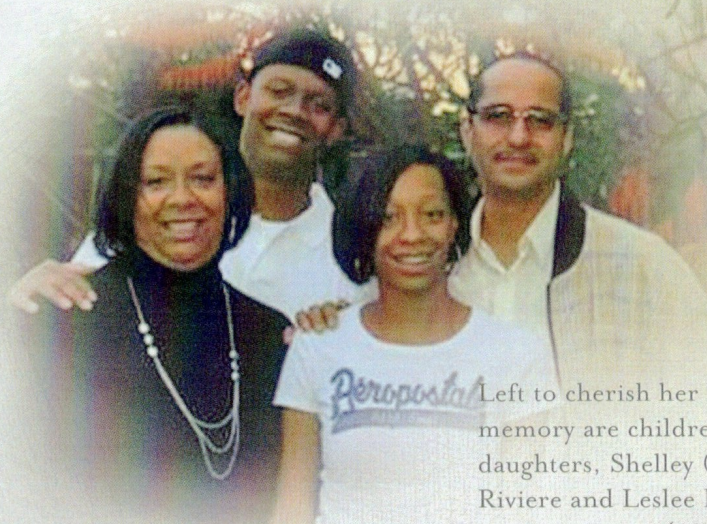

Mrs. Barbara Jean Lindsey

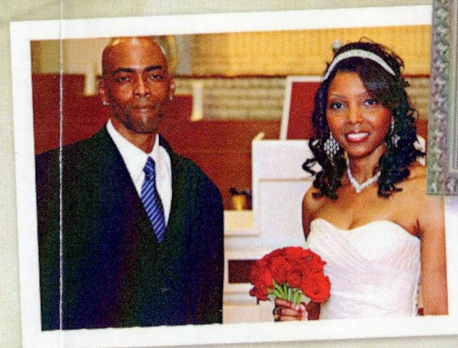
May 8, 1935 – October 26, 2021
