JB was a professional disc golfer and world champion. He won over 80 tournaments with the most notable being the 2011 PDGA Professional Disc Golf World Championship at his home disc golf course, DeLaveaga in Santa Cruz. He was also very proud to have been selected by his peers to receive the Bob West Memorial Sportsmanship award in 2013 and was often referred to as “Gentleman Jon”.

Jon was an avid photographer of nature, where he saw beauty and peace everywhere. His favorite subjects included ocean waves and the sandy beaches, the fog blanketing fields and forests, the majesty of the sky and the beautiful shapes to be found in the grains of wood. And not to forget the beauty of the disc golf courses he played on. His pictures will forever decorate our homes and our hearts.

Jon struggled with depression his entire adult life, and yet made a lasting impact on so many lives. As L. Frank Baum wrote in *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz* about the Tin Man, “A heart is not judged by how much you love; but by how much you are loved by others.”
