Now all we have is memories.

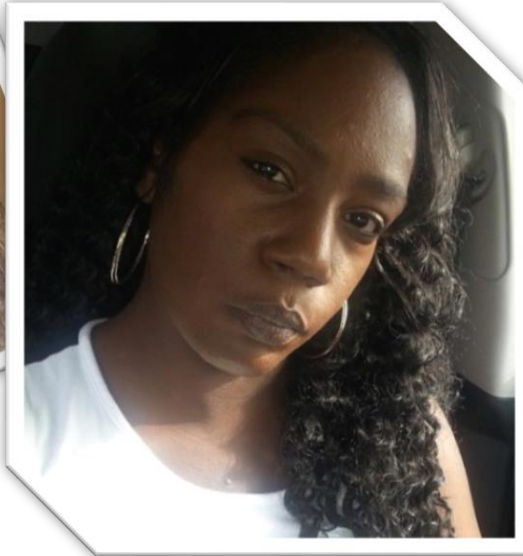
And your picture in a frame.

We have you in our heart.

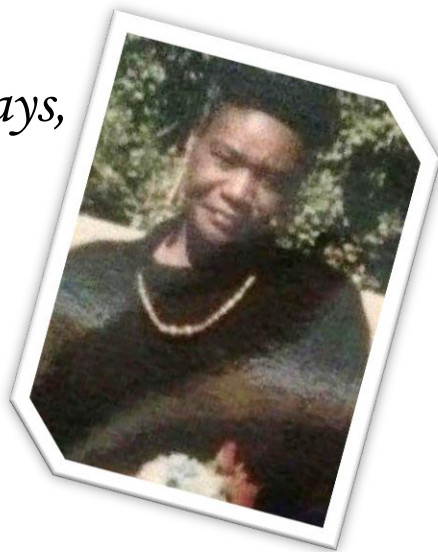
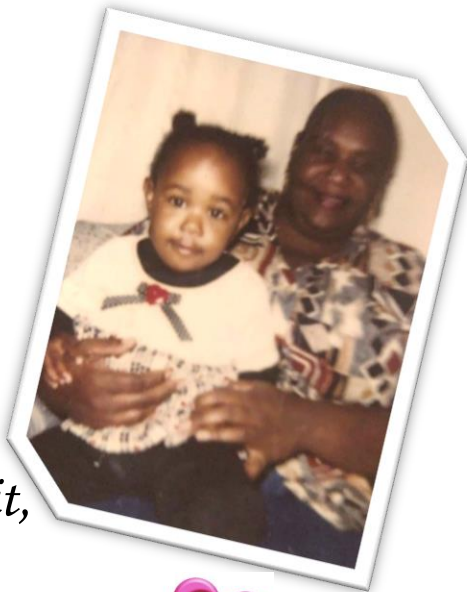
