"Grieve not for me."

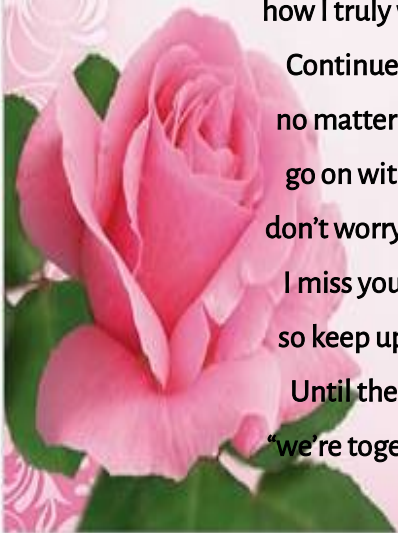
Remember the best times,
