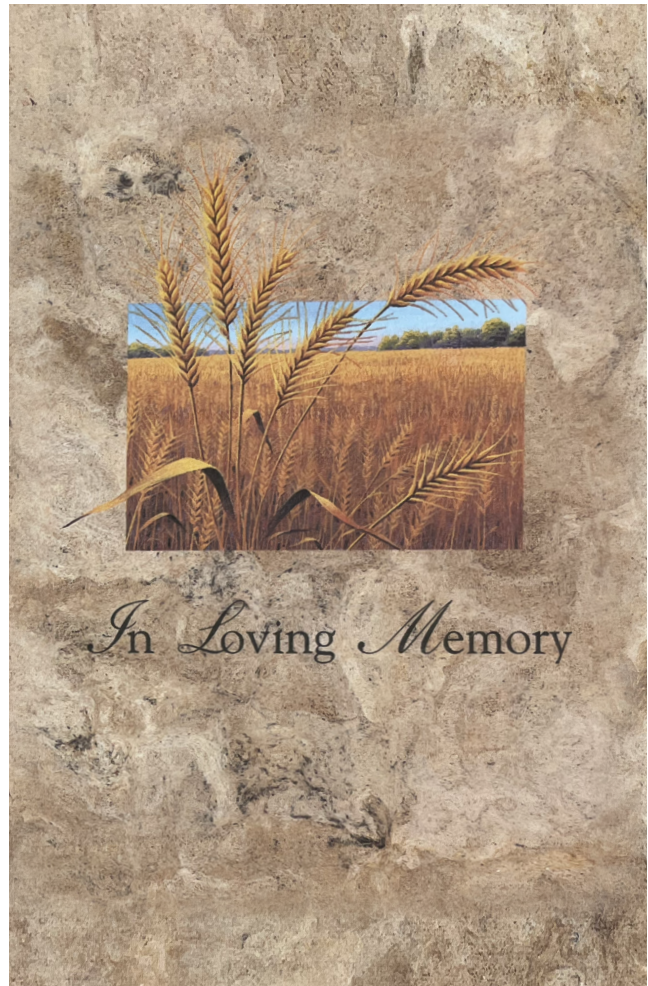
He was preceded in death by his parents, William and Mary Fate.
