

When Tomorrow Starts Without Me

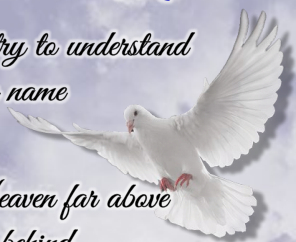
*When tomorrow starts without me, Please try to understand

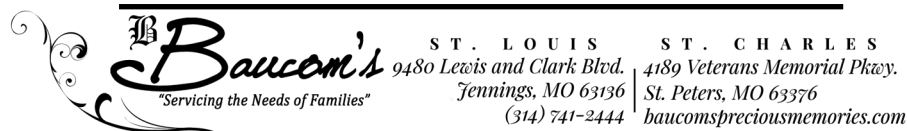
