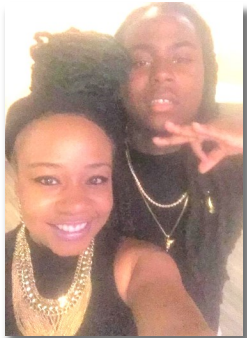
Darren was preceded in death by his grandmother Lizzie Alexander, his grandfather Columbus Alexander, and his grandfather Charles Scott.
