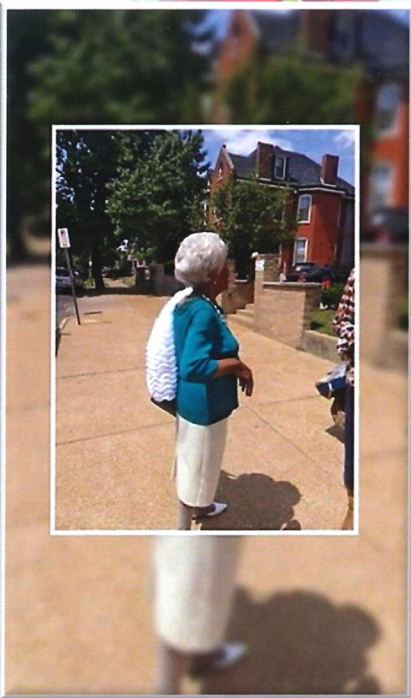
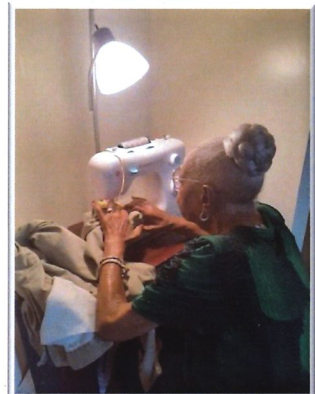


# Precious Memories
