Life Reflections

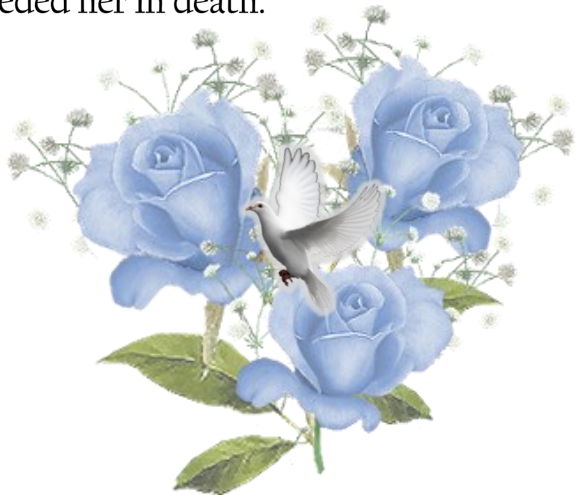
LATRICIA M. EDWARDS was born October 19, 1955 to the union of Emma Dixon and Arthur Cornell in Kinloch, Missouri.
