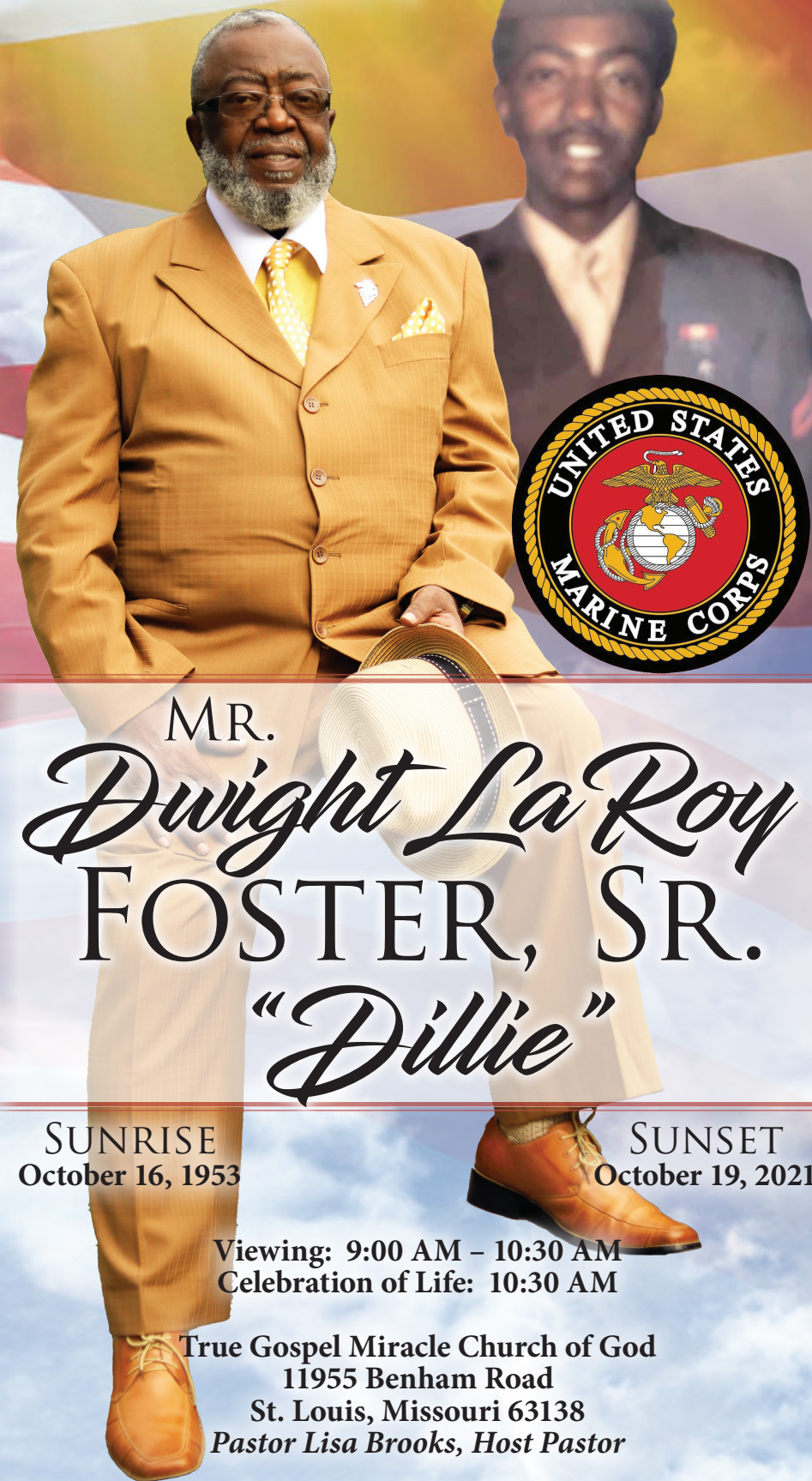

THE LIFE REFLECTIONS OF *Dwight LaRoy Foster, Sr.*

Dwight LaRoy Foster, Sr., was born to Harold and Barbara J. Tate on October 16, 1953, in St. Louis, Missouri. He was raised by his parents and his grandmother, Mattie Foster, who all preceded him in death. He was the oldest of six children, three of whom preceded him in death: Harold K. Foster, Ronald Tate, and Sharon Foster.

He was educated in the St. Louis public school system, where he proudly represented his high school, Beaumont High. Starting his career journey, he served honorably and with great pride, both the U.S. Marine Corps and the U.S. Army Reserve.

Prior to his union, Dwight Foster, Sr., welcomed his first beautiful child, Erika Wingo. On May 25, 1974, he married the love of his life, Ruth E. Gordon. To this union Dwight LeRoy Foster, Jr., and Chelsea Janine Foster were born.
