Beulah Nona McClenney, affectionately known as "NoNo" or Cherokee, was born in Searcy, Arkansas on June II, 1935. She was the second born of three children born to Lennie Brooks.

NoNo attended Arkansas Public Grammar School, and attended Pine Street High School in Conway, Arkansas

NoNo eventually left Arkansas and moved to Chicago, IL where she worked at the Zenith TV Factory. Later in life, she was employed by the United States Postal Service where she worked until she was limited by her disability. NoNo was also very talented and was a Kitchen Hairdresser as well.

NoNo confessed her faith at an early age. While in Chicago, she was a faithful member at Big Zion Missionary Baptist Church, under the leadership of Reverend C.L. Thomas. 
