Even in her illness, she continued to work diligently as president of the Trustee Spouse's Ministry, secretary of the Board of Christian Education, member of the Health and Wellness Ministry, chairperson of the Angel Tree Ministry and as a volunteer with the Food Pantry.

Rochelle received her formal education in the public schools of Williamsburg County. She earned her bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Benedict College, Columbia, South Carolina. After graduation from Benedict College, she was employed with the Johnson, Toal and Battiste Law Firm. She later joined the staff of Midlands Technical College where she served as Director of Procurement for nearly thirty years. Rochelle served as president of South Carolina Government Purchasing Officials (SCAGPO). She was an avid community activist. She worked on several political campaigns. Rochelle was the founder of the Sickle Cell Anemia Disease Society (SCADS) of Williamsburg County, in honor of her sister Vernell P. Graham, a sickle cell warrior.
