loved so much.

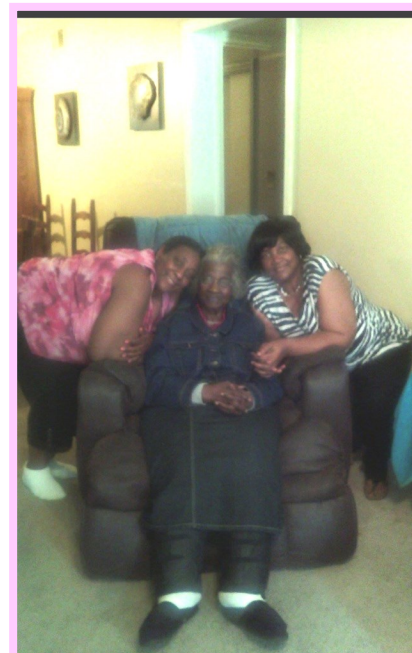

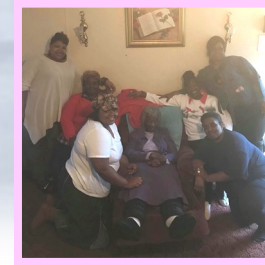
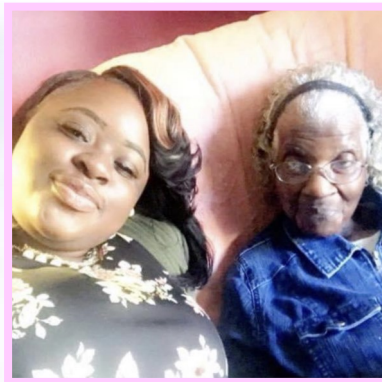
