MR. EARNEST ROY BAKER, SR., was born July 27, 1940 to the union of Maebell and Clarence Baker in Salisbury, Maryland.


Earnest Baker, Sr., received his formal education in Pompano Beach, Florida, graduating from Blanch Ely High school.
